SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

A public hearing to hear comments on the financing documents is required by the State of North Carolina when entering into an installment purchase contract for bank financing pursuant to N.C.G.S. 160A-20(g). The notice of the public hearing shall be published once at least 10 days before the hearing. This notice was duly advertised in the <u>Times-News</u> on Thursday, March 10, 2005.

Staff will be bringing final financing documents back to the Board for approval at a future meeting in April 2005.

At 11:00 a.m. the Chairman stated that the purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing to take public comment on the proposed financing documents to finance the construction of the new Human Services Building and construction and renovations at Dana Elementary School.
The Chairman asked for a motion to open the public hearing. Ata.m. Commissioner moved that the public hearing be opened and the motion was unanimously adopted.
The public hearing was opened so that anyone who wished to be heard on the proposed project and the installment financing documents could be heard. The Finance Director presented an affidavit of an officer of the Time News showing publication on March 10, 2005 of a Notice of Public Hearing to be attached to this extract as Exhibit A .
The Finance Director presented drafts of an Installment Financing Contract, a Deed of Trust and Security Agreement, an Indenture of Trust Agreement, an Agency Agreement, a Lease Agreement and the Contract of Purchase, all related to the proposed issuance of Certificates of Participation to finance the construction of a new Human Services Building and construction and renovations at Dana Elementary School. Copies of the financing documents have been on file with the County Manager and the Finance Director. The Finance Director stated that these documents in final form would be brought back to the Board for approval at a later meeting.
The Chairman inquired whether there were any persons who wished to speak at the public hearing.
