This is a project to extend existing water lines to provide water service to proposed residential subdivision consisting of 20 lots. This project is located on the south side of US Hwy 64 East.

This project is under the reviewing jurisdiction of: Henderson County.

This project requires approximately 1808 linear feet of water line sized as following:
