#### **PROJECT SUMMARY**

The proposed project is an extension of the CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT water system. The proposed water system will connect to the existing system in the shoulder of Sugar Loaf Road in front of the subject property east of the City of Hendersonville.

The project will include approximately 1,345 lf of 8" waterline and associated appurtenances to serve one elementary school with domestic water service and fire protection sprinkler system.

The proposed system has sufficient capacity and pressure to provide domestic service to the proposed building. Fire demands cannot be met with current system demands, but we understand that the City is currently planning for system expansion in the area that will improve fire flows throughout the vicinity.

The project is proposed for construction in April of 2006.



#### ADDENDUM TO ENGINEER'S REPORT

#### Water Line Extension – Sugar Loaf Road Elementary School Henderson County Schools Hendersonville, NC

The proposed project is an extension of the CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT water system. The project will include approximately 1,545 lf of 8" DIP,CL350 waterline, 1 fire hydrant, 2 Reduced Pressure Backflow Preventers and associated appurtenances to serve a 84,800 S.F. Elementary School with water service and fire protection sprinkler system (by others). The project is proposed for construction in April of 2006. Additional information as described in 15A NCAC 18C .0307 is as follows:

- 1. The proposed extension will connect to an existing 8" water main of the CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT located in State Route 1734 (Sugar Loaf Road) east of Hendersonville.
- 2. The proposed water line extension will serve the proposed building in one phase.
- 3. The applicant is: City of Hendersonville Water & Sewer Department Contact: Lee Smith (Director)
- 4. The proposed service area addition is domestic only and serves one school building.
- 5. No future expansion is anticipated.
- 6. Connecting to the CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT water system was the most favorable option for the addition.
- 7. N/A
- 8. The water system is to serve one 84,800 SF school facility. The anticipated average water usage is 7,800 G.P.D. See item 13 for the current water system usage and production.
- 9. Water is to be supplied to this extension by the CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT.

- 12. The proposed water line extension is to be constructed of Ductile Iron, CL 350 with a minimum design service life of fifty years.
