The City of Hendersonville has requested County comments on a proposed water line extension project to serve Fox Glen, Phase 1, Section 2 development.

City of Hendersonville - Project Summary Water Line Extension Fox Glen, Phase 1, Section 2

Date: April 3, 2006

This is a project to extend existing water lines to provide water service to a proposed residential development. This project consists of one hundred (100) apartment units and one (1) commercial office/retail unit. This project is located on Howard Gap Road across from Fletcher Elementary School.

This project is under the reviewing jurisdiction of: Henderson County.

This project requires approximately 1,156 linear feet of water line sized as following:

Description:	Approximate Length
6" DIP CL 350	1,156 lf

Fire Protection will be provided by the installation of two (2) fire hydrants and a private fire sprinkler system in each building.

The entire cost of the proposed water line extension is to be paid for by Glade Holdings, Inc. of Hendersonville, NC.

Water pressure and flow in this area is as follows:

Static Pressure:	78 PSI
Residual:	45 PSI
Flow:	785 GPM

Based on the above information, the Water & Sewer department is capable of supporting the additional connections and recommends approval of the project contingent upon approval of the final plans and specifications from the Water & Sewer Department.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND NARRATIVE

Fox Glen is a proposed residential community. The project has frontage on Howard Gap Road (SR # 1006) and is located on the east side; across from the Fletcher Elementary School. The property is outside the city limits of Hendersonville.

The current plan and permit provides for the development of one-hundred (100) residential units (apartments) and one (1) commercial building on 6.61 acres.

CURRENT PROJECT NARRATIVE

The proposed water distribution system includes water-main extension (6-inch water-line: 1157.0 lf) and required appurtenances to serve only the Fox Glen – Phase 1 Section 2 neighborhood; with 101 possible connections.

IDENTIFICATION and DESCRIPTION of the SERVICE AREA

The service area for this project is only the Fox Glen - Phase 1 Section 2 community.

FUTURE SERVICE AREAS

Future water-line extensions around the project will serve the surrounding area. This Water system extension is proposed to serve only the Fox Glen Apartment community.

PRESENT and ANTICIPATED WATER DEMAND

There is no current water use. When this phase is completed, the anticipated water demand will be <u>40,400</u> GPD (101 units @ 400 GPD).

CHARACTER of the WATER SUPPLY SOURCE

The water supply for this project is from the City of Hendersonville Water Treatment Plant.

CITY of HENDERSONVILLE

SUPPLEMENT TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1000.1 The installation of all water lines and appurtenances shall comply with the technical specifications and especially reflecting the typical details found on the approved plans.
- 1000.2 No deviations of the plans or technical specifications will be allowed without the express written authorization of the Director of Water and Sewer of the City of Hendersonville or his representative.
- 1000.3 Contractor is required to request authorization to start construction at least seven (7) days prior to actual starting date to the Director of Water and Sewer of the City of Hendersonville Water and Sewer Department.
- 1000.4 Contractor is required to coordinate pressure testing, line flushing, chlorination and final inspection with the engineering department of the City of Hendersonville.
- 1000.5 Contractor is required to install fire hydrants in strict compliance with the notes found on the detail sheet.
- 1000.6 Contractor is required to coordinate a continuity test with the engineering department of the City of Hendersonville at each water line appurtenance location to ensure that all water lines and service laterals can be located.
