SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners recently approved a Public Nuisance Ordinance. This ordinance was approved to be effective in the Henderson County Zoning Jurisdiction which does not allow enforcement in Hendersonville's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ). This amendment will allow Henderson County to enforce the Public Nuisance Ordinance in the ETJ.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUISANCE PREVENTION
ORDINANCE IN HENDERSON COUNTY**

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. Section 126-2.01 of the Henderson County Code (that provision entitled "Jurisdiction" of the Ordinance to Prevent Certain Nuisances) is amended by striking the same, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Jurisdiction. This chapter shall apply to all the land in Henderson County lying outside the incorporated boundaries of any municipality.

2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
