WATER SUPPLY FOR KENMURE DEVELOPMENT

Dear Mr. King:

As the provider of water service to Kenmure and surrounding areas, it shall be the City's perpetual responsibility to insure that the level of service is optimized and that neither quality nor quantity are sacrificed for the provision of such services to others. It shall always be the City's charge to insure that consistent and satisfactory levels of service be provided to the City's existing water customers, irregardless of new development and growth.

At some point in the future the water system serving Kenmure will reach its capacity and will require upgrading. Funding for this upgrade will be done on a pro rata basis determined by the actual and projected demand for each affected system connected to this existing water system. As new development may be proposed to connect to this and other existing portions of the City's water system, the City will require said new development to pay for its portion of upgrade that may be required while the City will provide funding to upgrade infrastructure required to maintain demand requirements for existing customers.



Description:

This proposed Sanitary Sewer Extension is being planned to serve proposed residential development in the southwest corner of the existing Kenmure development on the south side of Pinnacle Mountain Road (SR 1114). The project is located approximately 3 miles south of Hendersonville on the west side of US 225. This sanitary sewer extension is being done in-house by the City of Hendersonville's Water and Sewer

This proposed sewer system will require a new pumping station located in the southern portion of the proposed development and a 4" force main running north through the proposed development and through portions of the existing Kenmure Development for approximately 9,200 linear feet. This project consisting of 73 residential units will produce an estimated sewage flow of 400 gallons per residential dwelling unit which will generate an approximate total flow of 29,200 gallons per day. This sewer force main shall be installed according to the proposed plans and as follows:

OFF-SITE SEWER EXTENSION;

A proposed connection to the existing Town of Flat Rock sewer system shall be made

by connecting the proposed 4" diameter force main into an existing manhole at the existing pump station near the Kenmure Golf Course.

Approximately 7,600 lineal feet of 4-inch diameter DIP sanitary sewer line will be extended southward from the existing Town of Flat Rock pumping station to the proposed development along the south side of Pinnacle Mountain Road. This sanitary sewer force main and all other appurtenances necessary to provide adequate sewerage distribution shall be installed.

ON-SITE SEWER FORCEMAIN;

Approximately 1,600 lineal feet of 4-inch diameter ductile iron sanitary sewer line will be extended southward from Pinnacle Mountain Road into the proposed development to a proposed 26 horsepower Non Clog KSB pump station with grinder. This sanitary sewer force main and all other appurtenances necessary to provide adequate sewerage distribution shall be installed.

In General;

The installation of this Sanitary Sewer Force main is expected to begin shortly after all approvals and permits have been issued and "authorization to start" has been given by the City's Water and Sewer Department. The utility contractor for this project will be determined at a later date and the City Water and Sewer Department will be notified.

This is a sanitary sewer extension for the City of Hendersonville Water and Sewer Department. This sewer extension shall be installed in accordance with all local and state regulations by a N.C. licensed utility contractor to be selected by the Owner/Developer and approved by the Water and Sewer Department.

Laughter, Austin and Associates, P.A. (Consulting Engineers) shall provide installation monitoring services during the construction and installation process and provide completion certification when the job is completed as required by the City Of Hendersonville Water and Sewer Department.
