SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Henderson County is eligible to receive funds for a Housing Development Program in 2006 through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the Division of Community Assistance. In keeping with the Citizen Participation Plan, two public hearings are required. This is the second public hearing in accordance with CDBG regulations. The purpose of the first public hearing was to give citizens the opportunity to express their views and proposals prior to the formulation of the application.

Henderson County will consider an application for infrastructure to 13 new homes for Habitat for Humanity's Shuey Knolls subdivision which offers affordable housing for low-income families. The requested funding is \$234,000.

The application will seek funding estimated at \$234,000 for the installation of public infrastructure for 13 new houses located in the Edneyville community.
