Race Details: Race day is <u>Sunday, August 19th</u> with a start time of 3:30 p.m. <u>Teams should arrive at the park no later than 3:15 pm.</u> Teams may be composed of elected officials or a mixture of elected officials and staff, but no more than two public safety staff. All equipment (rafts, paddles, life jackets) is provided. Safety personnel will be on the scene in case of any mishap. There is no entry fee.

Captains and crews will meet at the French Broad River Park on Amboy Road in Asheville. The teams will sprint approximately 100 yards to the finish line at the park. The presentation of the *Pepsi "Mayor's Cup"* and ribbons will follow shortly after the completion of the race.
