#### **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:**

As outlined in the attached presentation, we can better utilize the current and future Solid Waste funding budgeted for HHW/E by developing a permanent, on-site center instead of single day events. This option would provide the following:

- 1. Significant improvements in customer service
- 2. Notable cost savings
- 3. More budget control

**BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:** Staff is requesting Board approval to develop a permanent HHW/E Center at the County's Solid Waste Facility.

## **Permanent HHW/E Center**

In the report to the Board after last year's HHW/E Event, I stated,

"The HHW/E Event was successful and very productive; however, there has to be a better way to do it"

The answer: A Permanent, On-Site Facility

#### Permanent, On-Site Facility

- Provide Significantly Better Customer
  Service than a One Day Event
- Provide Significant Cost Savings in Comparison to a One Day Event
- Provide Better Control Over HHW/E Budget

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### Permanent HHW/E Center

### **Better Customer Service**

- The permanent would be open on regular scheduled dates throughout the year
- The lines would be less due to more frequent scheduling
- More accommodating to Customer's schedules due to more frequent scheduling

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#### **Cost Savings**

- Cost Break Down from Last Single Day Event:

LOSRC Event Management		\$10,988
EcoFlow Mobilization		\$14,562
Cost of Processing Material		\$29,239
ECO Volunteers		No charge
	Total	\$54,789

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# **Permanent HHW/E Center**

Cost Savings, Set up & Operating Costs for Permanent Facility (from actual proposal):

Total	\$32k - \$57,000
Cost of Processing Material	\$24,268
Staffing	current
HHW DEHNR Permit, Training, & Grant Application	\$2,400 to \$3,500
Possible DPPEA Grant	(\$25,000)
HHW Building	\$30,000

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#### **Cost Savings**

- Annual cost of processing HHW with a permanent facility is 17% less then the unit prices with the past single day event
- With a successful grant, a permanent facility can process the same HHW/E as the single day event for much less cost (almost the case without the grant)

### Permanent HHW/E Center

### **Budget Control**

- With a permanent facility, we can close the facility when if the HHW budget is expended.
- With a single day event, the impact on the budget is determined a month after the event when the invoice is received.
- Buncombe County's last single day event cost:
  \$250,000. Buncombe, Transylvania and Madison all now have permanent facilities and all received grants for them.

During the last **Solid Waste Advisory Committee** meeting on November 19, the committee voted unanimously in favor of developing a permanent HHW/E center.
