SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Due to an address change for the Health Department, a new application of 45+ pages is required to be completed in order to bill Medicare for Influenza vaccination services. During Medicare's edit of submitted form #855, all but three items were accepted. A letter attesting the relationship between the Henderson County Department of Public Health and the County of Henderson needs to be submitted on official County letterhead, rather than the letterhead of the Health Department. This letter is critical as partial fulfillment to get authorization for payment of services already rendered and for future reimbursement of Medicare approved services. For example, this year \$62,000 is an outstanding bill owed Henderson County by Medicare to cover the cost of Influenza vaccine.
