David Whitson gave a brief overview of the master facility plan, and Celeste Oprean provided information in regards to the new programs that are being offered at the Technology Center.

Assistant County Manager Selena Coffey updated the Board of Commissioners on the seizure of 44 animals, 29 dogs and 15 cats, from a Flat Rock home by the Sheriff's Department Animal Enforcement Division. Ms. Coffey summarized that the animals were taken from the home after several complaints from neighbors. Of the animals taken, 4 were taken immediately to a veterinarian for medical treatment and the remaining 40 animals are being housed at the Animal Services Center.
