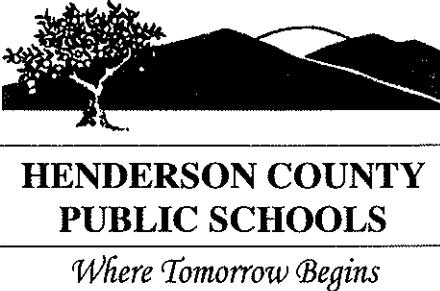

Dear Bill:

Please find attached eight copies of the comprehensive quarterly report of the Henderson County Public Schools Capital Outlay as of June 30, 2008, for your use and distribution to County Government. The report is formatted into specific areas of need. For example, the items required by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA), are listed under the category, "ADA Reg." The only expenditure from this category for fiscal year 2007-2008 was for East Henderson High School's field house and public restrooms. The generous contribution by a private citizen to provide a building, including construction labor, made this expenditure necessary to meet building code requirements for the parts that were left to the school. No other ADA projects were completed.

The entire Capital Outlay Budget was spent on the most critical needs of the school system. Many of the items were mandated by law or by inspectors. Of special note is what has not been addressed. With only a couple of exceptions, there has been no replacement carpeting in our schools. We had no choice but to replace wet and mildewed carpet in the chorus room at East High caused by a leaking roof. We also paid for carpet to complete a project held over from 2006-2007 at Rugby Middle School. The only painting done in the schools has been accomplished by parents, teachers and administrators. We only provided the paint.

Overall, the capital outlay projects fell in line with the adopted budget, except when emergencies dictated substituting items for work originally scheduled to be accomplished. An example of such an emergency was the mitigation for cracks in the exterior wall at Hendersonville High School. Another was the required replacement of the fire alarm system at Balfour. We would be glad to provide additional information and/or answer questions on any part of the budget or schedule of projects at a Joint Facilities meeting or at your regular meeting.

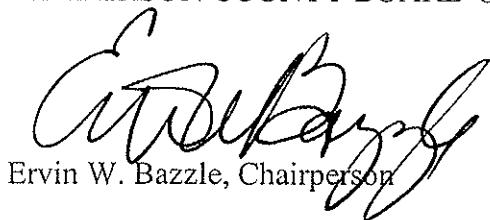

The need for capital outlay resources continues to grow. We are slipping farther behind at the current funding level and have conservatively documented over \$4,200,000.00 in projects that need immediate attention. Two million square feet of floor space cannot be properly maintained at the present funding level.

I have asked the Superintendent to redouble efforts to seek volunteer support. Volunteers can accomplish some tasks with professional support and guidance. Painting classrooms and hallways is one such area; however, there are painting projects that cannot be done by volunteers. One item on our list of needs was the crumbling chimney at East Henderson High School. Last year we were questioned concerning the \$20,000.00 estimate provided for the repair. Subsequent to that, we were provided with a professional estimate of \$30,970.00. What would seem like a simple matter of removing some crumbling bricks turns out to be more complicated when you consider protecting the existing building roof, removing the debris from the site as well as from the interior base of the chimney, and then forming and pouring a new concrete cap. Add to this an estimate of \$9,000 for a new chimney lining. Volunteers cannot do work of this magnitude.

In December 2007 we produced a list of unfunded facility projects and needed repairs. (See attached.) The total at that time was \$4,210,365.00. I am confident the number and cost of such projects will only increase. The School Board looks forward to having open and frank conversations concerning our capital needs. We sincerely hope to work cooperatively with the Board of Commissioners to find an effective way to fund these projects.
