### **Grant Contract L08004**

- Submitted required paperwork to NC DENR and received all monies involved with the grant contract L08004 prior to the 08 09 budget year.
  - \$33,784.80 grant

### **Status Summary**

- The erosion control division has been in operation for one year.
  - processed 56 erosion and sedimentation control plans.

*Note:* Land disturbance  $\geq 1$  acre.

- -Amount of land disturbance?
  - -414.37 acres

### **Status Summary (cont'd)**

- Amount of permit application fees for these reviews? \$145,500.00
  - -Note: Budget Revenue 2007-2008 projected \$159,795.00.

Fell short \$14,295.00 but funds were from October 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 not a full fiscal year.

July 1, 2008 – October 22, 2008 \$26,000.00 (12 sets plans) + \$10.00/sketch plan x 190 = \$1900.00.

Total \$27,900.00

## **Status Summary (cont'd)**

-processed approximately 780 sketch plans during the first year.

*Note: Land disturbances* < 1 acre.

-processed 255 complaints, out of which 244 have been resolved.

## **Status Summary (cont'd)**

- Complaints being resolved within 15 business days.
  - -75% of the complaints are being resolved in less than 15 business days.

### **Status Summary (cont'd)**

- Large Scale Plan reviews are going well. (> 1 acre)
  - -We initially set the goal for review of plans to be 15 days or less. The average being around 12 days.
    - 31 of the submittals have met the 15 day turnaround.

# Goals for Next update from May 5 2008 presentation

- Plan reviews for large scale plans
  - -Striving for 100% reviews being done under 15 days. Have not achieved this goal yet we are at 70%, but will be 100% soon.

# Goals for Next update from May 5 2008 presentation (cont'd)

 Striving for 85% complaints being resolved in less than <u>15</u> business days. The goal before was 85% in less than <u>30</u> days.

# DENR Review of Local Program (cont'd)

- Good Visit:
  - -pleased with our record keeping
  - prompt inspections of permitted sites
  - impressed with response time to complaints.

# DENR Review of Local Program (cont'd)

 He had a few suggestions that were implemented immediately.

## DENR Review of Local Program (cont'd)

- He asked that <u>all</u> Local Erosion and Sedimentation Programs monitor ground cover more aggressively.
  - Reason: Developers of large scale projects have been walking away from projects and leaving them unattended due to the economy.

# DENR Review of Local Program (cont'd)

- Use standardized forms located on their website for notice of violations and citations.
  - Reason: Some local programs have had cases overturned in court.
