### **2009 ANNUAL REPORT**

The Henderson County Local Emergency Planning Committee held quarterly meetings at Binion's Restaurant, Hendersonville, NC. The LEPC worked on several projects this year including a Hazardous Materials Commodity Flow Survey on I-26 in which we logged 435 loads of hazardous materials in a 24 hour period. The LEPC also reviewed the Pandemic Flu Response Plan, the Hazard Mitigation Plan and the County Emergency Operations Plan.

The Henderson County LEPC received Hazardous Materials Inventory Reports from 59 businesses located within the county and incorporated municipalities utilizing a newly implemented electronic submission program sponsored by the US Department of Homeland Security, the US Environmental Protection Agency and the University of Texas. These reports are maintained in an electronic database called E-Plan for emergency planning, response and public access purposes in accordance with the North Carolina Emergency Planning and the Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986.
