SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Per the Board's recent direction, staff has met with the Agri-Business Development Board of Directors Chairman, Danny McConnell and has scheduled the first meeting of the Agri-Business Board for Wednesday, March 9th at 5:00pm in the Historic Courthouse Community Room. - FY 2011 Available funding exceeds anticipated 4th Quarter costs. However, funding is available for unanticipated expenditures. Any unexpended funds will return to fund balance at June 30, 2011.
- ◆ Both budgets assume Director's salary at \$75,000 annually.

 Preliminary staff recommendations have been based on funding the Partnership at 100% for Year 1, 80% for Year 2, and 60% for Year 3 and subsequent years.
