SUBJECT: Set public hearing date regarding the re-naming of a portion of Bronco Pass

SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Planning Department staff requests the Board to set a public hearing to consider re-naming a portion of Bronco Pass to Maplewood Knoll Drive. Bronco Pass is currently an impassable road broken into two distinct sections. NCDOT will be improving the intersection of these two streets making them in sense one complete road (Maplewood Knoll Drive). The re-naming of this road segment requires the assignment of a new property address for 1 home.

The naming or renaming of the street is required by the Henderson County Property Addressing Ordinance (Chapter 142). North Carolina General Statute 153A-239.1 and the Property Addressing Ordinance require the Board to hold a public hearing prior to assigning a new road name. Assignment of the new road name will avoid possible confusion when responding to emergency situations.

The Planning Department staff requests the Board to set a public hearing for May 2, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed road name assignments. The Board may take action after conducting the hearing.
