RE: FY2011-2012 Capital and Maintenance Budget First Quarter Report (August, September and October 2011)

Dear Mike:

During the School Board's October 11, 2011, regular business meeting, we received the FY2011-2012 Capital and Maintenance Budget First Quarter Report. Enclosed are copies of our Capital Outlay Budget, the Capital Outlay Fund (as of September 30, 2011), and a spreadsheet of completed projects for the first quarter. As you will note, we have indicated when local vendors were used. Below is a summary of the projects and expenditures referenced in the report.

The vast majority of the projects identified on the spreadsheet reflect expenditures to increase energy efficiency in various aspects of our facilities; more specifically, lighting, HVAC upgrades, and Variable Frequency Drivers (VFD) installed in our older and less efficient heating and cooling systems. We also plan to replace the inefficient windows in disrepair at Bruce Drysdale Elementary.

As the spreadsheet indicates, the largest single expenditure (\$232,500) is the future roof replacement at Hendersonville Elementary. It was recently discovered that instead of a relatively small and isolated roof repair, the entire roof must be replaced. Therefore, the Capital Outlay Fund Initial Budget will have to be adjusted to reflect the necessary changes in expenditure allocations providing funds for the roof replacement. As of September 30, 2011, we have expended and encumbered \$56,021 of the total budget of \$1,007,500.

As always, I will be available to discuss any items referenced in this letter or enclosures. If you or any of the Commissioners have questions, please let me know.
