### **HENDERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

**SUBJECT:** Approval of the Low Bid and Purchase of Sheriff's Vehicles

#### **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:**

The Board is requested to approve the low bid and authorize the Sheriff to proceed with purchasing 10 Dodge Chargers, model year 2012. Bidding was conducted between September 29 and October 6, 2011. The low bidder is Egolf of Hendersonville for a total of \$222,190.00 (see attachment 1).

The Board is also requested to approve the low bid and authorize the Sheriff to proceed with purchasing two Chevrolet Tahoes, model year 2012. The low bidder is Asheville Chevrolet for a total of \$61,102.40 (see attachment 2).

All vehicles were approved in the Sheriff's Office FY 2012 budget, and all vehicles meet the County Vehicle Replacement Plan (and energy conservation) criteria.

#### **BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Board is requested to accept the low bids from Egolf of Hendersonville and Asheville Chevrolet, and authorize the Sheriff to proceed with the purchases.

#### **Suggested Motion:**

*I move the Henderson County Board of Commissioners accept the bids from Egolf of Hendersonville for ten 2012 Dodge Chargers, and from Asheville Chevrolet for two Chevrolet Tahoes, and authorize the Sheriff to proceed with the purchases.*

**SCOPE: FULL SIZE, DODGE CHARGER OR SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT, REAR-WHEEL DRIVE:**

1. 10- New 2012, four door sedan, rear wheel drive, five passenger, EPA large size, with police package.
2. Frontal crash rating of five stars from NHTSA.
3. Air Conditioning, factory installed.
4. Alternator, 220 amp rating.
5. Battery, heavy duty 12 volt, mfr's standard except minimum 800 CCA, maintenance free.
6. Electronic stability program with brake assist and all speed traction control.
7. Brakes: four wheel disc with anti-lock braking system.
8. Cooling system, heavy duty, automatic coolant recovery system with permanent type anti-freeze protected to -20 degrees F with rust inhibitor. Include silicone or EPDM type hoses.
9. Clock, dash mounted, in radio.
10. Differential, heavy duty.
11. Power window, all four doors.
12. Power locks, all four doors with operator override for rear door locks.
13. Engine, 8 cylinder, 370 HP, 5.7-Liter HEMI Multi-Displacement, including police package. EPA gas mileage rating of at least 16 City and 25 Highway.
14. Rear wheel drive.
15. Floor covering, black carpet, heavy duty with removable floor mats.
16. Truck to include full carpet covering.
17. Dome light in center of ceiling. Dome light door switches deactivated. White and red LED map reading light, mounted on ceiling between sun visors and controlled by a separate switch adjacent to light.
18. Halogen type head lights with factory installed wigwag headlights and taillights.
19. Glove compartment light and door lock.
20. Luggage compartment light.
21. Locks, all locks on a vehicle to be keyed alike. Four (4) keys for each vehicle. Four (4) key fobs.
22. Mirrors, inside with day/night adjustment.
23. Dual exterior mirrors on left and right side, remote controlled from driver's side for left and right side.
24. Spot Lamp, Dual, with Black finish
25. Exterior color, BLACK
26. Police equipment mounting track installed in floor between front seats. Side channeling for equipment installation, through firewall access grommet for wire installation.
27. Radio, manufacturer's standard AM/FM stereo with front and rear speakers.
28. Rear window defroster, electric (not blower type), with control within convenient reach of driver and clearly marked.
29. Remote controlled rear deck lid release. Control to be within convenient reach of driver (not in glove box). Preferred location is left of steering column. Remote release to be inoperable when ignition switch is in off position; this feature may be dealer provided. Remote release switch must be properly mounted, durable, and fully suited for law enforcement duty including operation during emergency conditions.
30. Remote hood release, inside.
31. Resistant type ignition wiring for radio noise suppression.
32. Seats: Rear fixed bench type. Front cloth buckets, with driver side 6 or 8-way power adjustable. Front seat cloth covering must be intended for heavy duty use. Rear seat, vinyl, colored same as front seats.
33. Seat belts and shoulder harnesses: Attachment to door is not acceptable.
34. Speedometer, certified calibrated speedometer (2 MPH increments) 3% accuracy.

35. Tilt steering wheel.
36. Power steering external oil cooler.
37. Tires, Four (4) tubeless, radial, black sidewall, all-season tread, P225/60R18, V-rated, approved and certified for pursuit use on the specific model and configuration of vehicle offered. One tire and wheel mounted in trunk for spare. Compact.
38. Transmission, 4 or 5 speed automatic. Transmission external oil cooler.
39. Full wheel covers.
40. Windshield wipers, multiple speed electric, intermittent type, with windshield washers.
41. Cruise control optional (if in standard equipment).
42. Driver's and front passenger's supplemental inflatable restraint system.
43. Column mounted transmission shift lever.
44. Dealer to provide activation of emergency equipment systems and related equipment as required by manufacturer specifications.
