RE: Henderson County Facility Projects Status Report

This report is a review of the scope and statuses of assigned construction projects and includes specific updates in regard to county funded construction activities. This report is a continuation of county construction activity statuses.

Henderson County School Projects

Henderson county School Staff: We continue to assist the Henderson County School staff with facility projects on an asneeded basis.

Also as requested and mandated by the Board of Commissioners, spreadsheet reports for all Henderson County School Capital Projects are included as attachments to this report. The first spreadsheet list all projects completed for the fiscal year 2011-2012 and the final total dollars encumbered (\$999,584) charged against the County appropriated \$1,000,000. The second spreadsheet is a listing, inclusive of cost estimates, for all proposed and projected future Henderson County School Capital Projects. This listing highlights projects that were initially planned for the fiscal year 2012-2013 totaling \$1,004,900, but also highlights a reduced scope of projects for the year totaling \$500,000. The reduced scope was mandated to school operations by the HC School Board and includes what they considered to be the highest priority projects.

Henderson County Projects

1995 Courthouse: Design proposals were generated by Moseley Architects that address the needs for added security within the 1995 Courthouse and for secured Courthouse parking areas. Also included in these proposals were designs for the relocation of the HC Tax Department within the Courthouse. The Tax Department is scheduled to move into the basement area of the 95 Courthouse which was vacated by the state employees when they moved to the newly renovated old health department building (Henderson County Court Services). From these design proposals a budget of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) was approved by the Board of Commissioners. While keeping the security issues of the project the priority, a directive was also given to have Moseley proceed in making whatever changes were necessary to the design proposals to reduce the previously estimated cost to within the approved budget amount. We anticipate receiving the revised design scope from Moseley Architects by mid-July, at which time, if approved, we will move toward requesting permission to release Moseley to prepare construction drawings for the project. Request for Proposals can then be acquired to have the project competitively bid and the work performed. We will also be planning in the near future to be meeting with courthouse departments that will possibly be making office adjustments to facilitate the use of the space in the courthouse where the Tax Department is currently located.

Law Enforcement Center/911: Approval was obtained from the Board of Commissioners to proceed with an RFQ (Request for Qualifications) to procure an architectural firm to design the 911 Center that will be located in the basement area of the newly completed Law Enforcement Center. A specific section of the unfinished basement area was designated for this purpose in the original design of the building. The RFQ will be posted the first week of July.

2010 Solid Waste Capital Improvements: Exclusive of minor punch list items, Cooper Construction, the general contractor, has now completed the final phases of the project. All aspects and improvements included in the scope of the project are currently successfully up and running.

Additionally and in efforts to make the facility even more productive, attractive, and functional, the Henderson County Central Services staff has and continues to work with the Solid Waste staff on several associated smaller project needs and repairs at the facility at no significant additional cost to the county. In particular, the Solid Waste garage facility has been significantly improved by upgrading tools, equipment, and the building itself in order to better maintain Solid Waste's heavy equipment. The Central Services garage staff is responsible for these improvements and by doing so is better able to minimize the outsourcing of equipment repairs at significant cost savings to the county.

Park Maintenance Projects: Note worthy park projects at this time would include the addition of twelve stop signs located at all crosswalks/speed tables at Jackson Park. The signs were installed at the direction of the Board of Commissioners to further improve the safety aspects of the park. The signs have helped to curtail the speeding situation significantly.

Additionally the Parks and Recreation Department in conjunction with Central Service are working to provide handicap swings at several park locations. The first swing has already been installed at Jackson Park with other locations being planned. Dugout improvements at Jackson Park fields #8 and #9 allowing for wheelchair participants are also being planned by the volunteers. This work has been approved and is scheduled to begin no later than the last week of July. The majority of the funding for the swings and dugout improvements is being provided for by the volunteers.

Central Services Planned & Special Projects: Completed Central services 2011-2012 budgeted planned projects included replacement of the sections of the Main Library carpet, the installation of needed computer automated HVAC controls for the King Street building, installation of automatic sliding doors at all three exterior door locations at the 1995 Courthouse, and the installation of keypad locks at the branch libraries. All of these projects were completed within or under budget. Planned 2012-2013 projects include King Street building roof drains installations, King Street parking lot repair/paving, carpet replacement at the main library, and EMS Station #1 bay garage door replacements.

Blue Ridge Community College

The completed project work inclusive of all associated cost was completed for less than the allocated HC two million dollar funding. This allowed for several additional scope components that were originally planned for, but were taken out due to initial cost concerns, to be planned and performed as a part of the overall project. The additional work is primarily paving/drainage of some parking lot areas. This additional work was surveyed and designed. The project to perform the work was bid/awarded during the month of June and is currently underway and is to be completed no later than mid August. We look forward to working with BRCC in getting the remaining work completed and bringing the project to a close.
