SUBJECT: Set a Public Hearing for a CDBG Application Regarding the Habitat for Humanity
Dodd Meadows Project

SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Henderson County Habitat for Humanity requests the County to apply for a CDBG Catalyst application on behalf of their Dodd Meadows neighborhood off Crest Road. The 2011 Catalyst grant cycle is beginning and Henderson County is eligible to apply for the \$250,000 grant. However, a process of hearings for the application is required. The Board has held the initial hearing and this second public hearing is required. The purpose of the second hearing is to receive public comment regarding the proposed application.

No local match (County funds) is required for this grant. The CDBG funds will be used to support Henderson County Habitat for Humanity's Dodd Meadows development by constructing roadway drainage and street improvement as well as water and sewer installation for approximately 14 homes in Phase II of the Dodd Meadows development.
