# **2012 ANNUAL REPORT**

The Henderson County Local Emergency Planning Committee held quarterly meetings at Binion's Restaurant, Hendersonville, NC. The LEPC worked on several projects this year including;

## Hazard Mitigation Plan:

The Hazard Mitigation Plan will be consolidated into a regional plan with 3-5 other counties and incorporated municipalities desiring to participate. The regional planning initiative will be funding by a federal hazard mitigation planning grant with the objective of combining individual planning efforts into a regional focus, thereby capturing the impact of disasters and disaster mitigation activities on a regional basis.

# County Emergency Operations Plan:

The emergency operations plan was updated with a specific focus on hazardous materials. Initiated with the assistance of a hazardous materials planning grant, the update started a project to develop a facility specific emergency response plan for every facility within the county utilizing extremely hazardous materials as defined by the Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act. Six facility plans were completed in 2012 and six more are scheduled for development in 2013 pending approval of a planning grant from the NC Division of Emergency Management.
