#### **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:**

ECO, the Environmental and Conservation Organization, will be hosting its third Strive Not To Drive Event on April 19th, 2013. Many people travel from place to place in one car by themselves. This is not the most efficient way to travel and with depleting fuel sources causing gas prices to rise, now is the time to learn about more sustainable forms of transportation. This event is going to focus on alternative forms of transportation that include the Apple Valley Transit, walking, and carpooling.

Last year over 300 residents found another way to get around on foot, through carpooling or just staying home. Six major employers played a key role in encouraging their employees to commute without solo driving including Pardee Hospital, Park Ridge Hospital, Henderson County, City of Hendersonville, Henderson County Schools, and Blue Ridge Community College. This year Park Ridge Hospital, Henderson County Schools, and the Hendersonville Community Co-Op have already committed to participate.

Strive Not To Drive is a chance for people around the area to learn about alternative modes of transportation and to save money on gas and travel.

# PROCLAMATION

### DECLARING FRIDAY APRIL 19, 2013 AS STRIVE NOT TO DRIVE DAY

WHEREAS, Henderson County is an exceptional place to live and work; and

- **WHEREAS,** reducing transportation fuel consumption can better sustain the quality of life for present and future generations; and
- WHEREAS, reducing fuel consumption reduces the amount of money exported out of the region; and
- WHEREAS, reducing fuel consumption reduces expenses for Henderson County residents; and
- WHEREAS, alternatives to vehicle use can promote a healthier and more enjoyable lifestyle; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Environmental and Conservation Organization is promoting these practices for the benefit of Henderson County residents together with local businesses, Blue Ridge Community College and the City of Hendersonville;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that we, the Henderson County Board of Commissioners, do hereby proclaim April 19, 2013 as "**Strive Not to Drive**" in Henderson County, and do further hereby urge every citizen to do his or her part to reduce their transportation fuel consumption by consolidating trips, carpooling, walking, biking, or telecommuting on April 19 and throughout the year.
