SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Each year, the Board of Commissioners is required to adopt a Funding Plan for the Home & Community Care Block Grant for Older Adults and identify the lead office or agency responsible for coordinating the County Funding Plan. The Home & Community Care Block Grant is a State/Federal program administered at the local level. The proposed Funding Plan supports the service priorities identified for the current planning cycle.

At this time, the HCCBG funding for FY2014 is estimated to be \$768,363. It is possible that this amount will change based on federal and state funding revisions resultant from Federal Sequestration. In the likely event that the amount does change, the HCCBG Committee has proposed implementing additional funding (or reductions in funding) to each provider based on the provider's prorata share of total HCCBG Funding.

BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff recommends designation of the County Manager's office as the Lead Agency or office and approval of the proposed FY2014 Funding Plan.

The last column entitled "% of FY2014 Allocation" indicates the percentage of total FY2014 HCCBG funding recommended by the Committee to be allocated for each provider.

The column above, entitled "FY2013 Current Allocation" reflects the FY2013 year-to-date allocations granted to providers. The amounts displayed in this column may differ from the amounts in the column entitled "FY2013 Original Allocation" because of (1) re-allocated funds among providers; and/or (2) additional HCCBG funds received from NC Division of Aging through the Land of Sky Regional Council; and/or (3) reductions due to Sequestration.

NOTES (Cont'd.)			
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HCCBG Services have been categorized in accordance with priority services established by Title III-B of the Older Americans Act. Specific services falling within each priority service category are set forth above and color coded for your convenience. Title III-B funding comprises *approximately* 30% of entire HCCBG funding (*approximately* \$230,509). According to Title III-B, the following funding requirements are imposed for three of the above-listed categories as follows (Henderson County meets all of the funding requirements): (1) In-Home Services: 25% (\$57,627); (2) Access Services: 30% (\$69,153); (3) Legal Services: 2% (\$4,610).
