The attachment provides information to the Board about the County's energy use across all County facilities in the areas of electricity, natural gas, and water/sewer. It compares the FY 15-16 4^{th} quarter with the previous year to illustrate historical trends in commodity consumption. Supplementary cost analyses represent the monthly cost profile comparing 2015 and 2016 YTD for the highest-cost commodity at each facility. Selected fuel consumption information is also provided for the FY 15-16 4^{th} quarter period.





Henderson County Fleet Conventional Fuel Consumption, Qtr. 4 FY15-16 (April-June)




Henderson County CNG Fleet Fuel Consumption, Quarter 4 FY15-16 (April - June 2016)*


WCCA Ridership Totals Compared to Total Gallons of CNG Consumed, April-June 2016


*Expense Breakdown of Henderson County Facilities in Total Costs YTD %


95 Courthouse Electricity Usage Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016












Animal Services Electricity Usage Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016







Board of Elections Electricity Use Comaprison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016

Central Services Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016



CNG Station Natural Gas Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016













Cooperative Extension Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016















A major water leak was detected in late November 2015 and was fixed by Henderson County Facilities Services; the abnormal usage is reflected in this graph.







Emergency Services Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016


Human Services Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016









King Street Utility Use




King Street Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016







Libraries Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016






Parks and Recreation Utility Use




Parks & Recreation Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016[^]








Sheriff's Complex Utility Use




Sheriff's Complex Electricity Use Comparison Qtr. 4, 2015-2016












Solid Waste Utility Use
