BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2017

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a regularly scheduled meeting at 5:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room of the Historic Courthouse on Main Street, Hendersonville.

CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Chairman Edney called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

INVOCATION

The invocation was provided by County Manager Steve Wyatt.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag was led by Commissioner Hawkins.

RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION – CAPTAIN TIM GORDON

Sheriff McDonald stated the Henderson County Sheriff's Office requests that the service badge and sidearm of Tim Gordon be given to him in recognition of his retirement from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office.

Captain Tim Gordon began his law enforcement career in 1986 when he attended BLET at the Salemburg campus of the North Carolina Justice Academy. He started out as a Patrol Officer with the Hendersonville Police Department where he was also a member of their SWAT team. In 1990, he joined the Henderson County Sheriff's Office where he has stayed with the Patrol Division and served in various capacities over the years such as Patrol Deputy, Patrol Corporal, Sergeant and Lieutenant and Warrant Squad Sergeant and is currently assigned as the Patrol Captain. Captain Gordon has served continuously on the Sheriff's Emergency Response Team where he is currently the Team Commander. He has also served as a Helicopter Pilot for the Sheriff's Aviation Unit and has acted as both a Firearms and Submachine Gun Instructor. Captain Gordon has an Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice and has been awarded both his Advanced Service Award and his Advanced Law Enforcement Certificate from the North Carolina Sheriff's Training Education and Standards Division. He is a graduate of the Western North Carolina Law Enforcement Leadership Academy and the 379th Class of the Northwestern University Center for Public Safety, School of Police Staffing and Command Academy.

Captain Tim Gordon has served for a total of 26 years in the Sheriff's Office. He has spent his adult life serving our community and agency. To honor him and show him our gratitude, the Sheriff's Office intends to present his service badge and service sidearm to him.

Sheriff McDonald makes this request on behalf of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 20-187.2(a).

Chairman Edney read the resolution aloud.

Chairman Edney made the motion that the Board allow Sheriff Charles McDonald to present the service badge and sidearm as a token of appreciation to Captain Tim Gordon. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

County Financial Report/Cash Balance Report - November 2016

The November 2016 County Financial Report and Cash Balance Report were provided for the Board's review and approval.

The following are explanations for departments/programs with higher budget to actual percentages for the month of November:

- Dues/Non-Profit Contributions 2nd quarter approved non-profit contribution payments
- Register of Deeds contracted services for document image conversion and scanning services
- Emergency Management the purchase/encumbrance of capital outlay in the approved budget
- EMS the purchase/encumbrance of four new ambulances in the approved budget
- Rescue Squad 2nd quarter approved non-profit contribution payment
- Agri-Business excess operating expenditures over \$120,000 that will be covered by membership fees
- Mental Health 2nd quarter maintenance of effort (MOE) payment to Vaya Health (formally the Smoky Mountain Center)
- Debt Service annual principal and interest payments scheduled/came due in November

The YTD deficit in the 911 Emergency Communications Fund is due to the budgeted payment of annual software and hardware maintenance contracts paid early in the new fiscal year.

The YTD deficit in the Innovative High School, Emergency Services Headquarters, Hendersonville High School and Law Enforcement Training Center Projects is due to the payment of architect fees for these projects from appropriated fund balance in the Capital Projects Funds that will be reimbursed from future

financing. The Innovative High School Project financing was closed on December 28, 2016.

The YTD deficits in the Detention Center and Recreation Parks Improvements Projects are being paid from appropriated fund balance in the Capital Projects Fund, proceeds from the sale of the Bent Creek property, as approved by the Board in the FY2017 budget.

The YTD deficit in the Westfeldt Park Project from project expenditures to date will be reimbursed from grant funds appropriated in the budget for FY2017. This reimbursement is anticipated to be received in early 2017.

Community Foundation of Henderson County, Inc. Grant Award, Child Passenger Safety Program

The Henderson County Department of Public Health was recently notified by the Community Foundation of Henderson County of a grant award of \$5,000 to continue the child passenger safety program and the provision of free car seats to families in need. The grant funds would be used exclusively for the purchase of car seats. The program includes a required training component for parents to ensure they are advised of proper installation and use of appropriate seats for the age and size of their child. Families are referred to the program for assistance by local agencies including the Department of Social Services, Western Carolina Community Action, SafeLight, Child and Family Resource Center, Rescue Mission and others.

Set Public Hearing for Rezoning Application #R-2016-04, Philip Fisher

Rezoning Application #R-2016-04, which was initiated on November 3, 2016 at the request of applicant, Philip Fisher, who requests the County rezone approximately 3.53 acres of land (thereafter the "Subject Area") from an Estate Residential (R-40) zoning district to a Residential Two Rural (R2R) zoning district.

TRC reviewed the application at the December 6, 2016 meeting and voted unanimously to send forth a favorable recommendation. Planning Board reviewed the rezoning request at the December 15, 2016 meeting and voted unanimously to send forth a favorable recommendation.

Request for Approval of Western Carolina Community Action 2017-2018 CDBG Grant

Deb Haight, Community Services Director is requesting approval of the Western Carolina Community Action (WCCA) Community Services Block Grant Program application.

This is the second year of the 3 year grant cycle. No funding is requested from the county, but WCCA is required by law to send the grant to the County Commissioners for a 30 day review and comment period.

For the 2017-2018 cycle of this three year grant, funding has been decreased by 13%, resulting in a subsequent decrease in the clients served and the services provided in each county.

I move that the Board approves the request for application by the Western Carolina Community Action of the 2017-2018 CSBG Grant, authorize the clerk to insert the date of January 3, 2017 on the appropriate page, and further authorize the clerk to execute such document.

Facility Use Policy Exemption

The County received an application from the Henderson County Girl Scouts to use the Historic Courthouse lawn on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., and Sunday from 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. between January 20th and March 5th, 2017. The specific request is to set up a small table on those dates to sell Girl Scout cookies.

To allow for this use on County grounds, the Board is requested to allow for a one-time exemption to rule #4 of the County Facility Use Policy, which prohibits solicitation on the grounds. This exemption, if granted, would cover the dates and times specified on the application, and outlined above.

Motion:

I move the Board grants an exemption to the County Facility Use Policy for the Henderson County Girl Scouts, allowing them to sell Girl Scout cookies on the Historic Courthouse lawn on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., and Sundays from 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. between January 20^{th} and March 5^{th} , 2017.

<u>UPDATE ON THE HENDERSON COUNTY JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL</u>

Mary Murray, Chair of the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council, provided an update to the Board on changes forthcoming in the juvenile age, and how they will impact the court system, the community and programming.

Ms. Murray informed the Board that currently there are two vacancies on the Council. One of those is a requirement for a student under the age of 18. Legislature is in the process of changing the make-up of the Council removing both student positions. Once we receive an application from the DA's Office we can fill the other position, having a fully seated council for the first time since 1999.

One of the main impacts will be after the state changes the maximum age at which persons can be considered a juvenile from 16 to 18. North Carolina is one of only two states remaining in the country that hadn't made that change, stated Ms. Murray.

Due to elevated costs for special sex abuse assessments and associated mental health evaluations this year, the JCPC plans to request an additional \$5,500 from the County to cover the costs. Housing may also become an issue.

COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT

Chairman Edney thanked staff for the New Year's Eve event which was a huge success.

Steve Wyatt had displayed boards with Resolutions and Predictions in the boardroom from the New Year's Eve event and stated some of them are very interesting.

Mr. Wyatt reminded the Board of the budget retreat on January 17th at 9:00 a.m. Staff has been busy preparing issues and options to share with the commissioners.

As always this time of year, the County Manager asked for predictions from the commissioners on the Alabama/Clemson football game.

Mike Edney – Clemson, Grady Hawkins – Alabama, William Lapsley – Clemson, Charlie Messer – Alabama Tommy Thompson – Clemson – by three points, Steve Wyatt – Clemson

Commissioner Lapsley recognized Steve Wyatt's alma mater Appalachian State University for winning the Bowl Game.

Resolution Honoring Captain Tim Gordon



For 30 Years of Law Enforcement Service and Awarding Him His Badge and Sidearm

WHEREAS, Captain Tim Gordon joined the Henderson County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy on February 19, 1990 and held the ranks of Deputy, Corporal, Sergeant, Lieutenant, and Captain; and

WHEREAS, Captain Gordon's service and dedication to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office and service, dedication and accomplishments in the field of law enforcement during his 30 years of service are hereby recognized and commended; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 provides that retiring officers of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office may receive, at the time of their retirement, the badge worn or carried by them during their service with Henderson County; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 further provides that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners may, in its discretion, award to a retiring officer the service sidearm of such retiring officer at a price determined by the Board of Commissioners, upon securing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. 14-402 et seq; and

WHEREAS, Captain Gordon has served as a member of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office for a period of more than 26 years and retired from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on November 30, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- Sheriff Charles McDonald is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Captain Gordon the badge worn by him during his service with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office; and
- 2. Sheriff McDonald is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Captain Gordon his service sidearm at no cost to the officer and upon his securing a permit required by N.C.G.S. 14-402.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners recognizes and thanks Captain Gordon for his dedicated service to Henderson County and its citizens.
