SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

At September 20, 2017, Board of Commissioners Meeting, staff presented a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) submitted by North Carolina Department of Transportation (NC DOT). This CLOMR was to replace an existing bridge on Hooper Lane located in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) on the border of Henderson County and the Town of Mills River. Henderson County is required to sign a community acknowledgment agreeing or disagreeing with the project. The majority of the affected properties are within the Town of Mills River jurisdiction. The Board directed staff to meet with Town of Mills River and see if they have concerns regarding the CLOMR as submitted.

Staff met with Town Manager Jeff Wells and Councilman Wayne Carland on September 21st. Town of Mills River staff requested our assistance in discussing their concerns with NC DOT hydraulics engineer.

NC DOT revised the CLOMR for the bridge replacement after our discussions. Two parcels of land are affected by the rise in flood waters, they both are in the Town of Mills River, and both are in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) (See attached map).

Town of Mills River staff is in agreement with the revised CLOMR.

BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Based on the Town's agreement with the CLOMR as revised, the Board is requested to approve the proposed project and direct the Project Engineer to execute the acknowledgment form accordingly.

Suggested Motion(s):

I move the Board approve the proposed project as revised, and direct the Henderson County Project Engineer to execute the community official acknowledgment form.
