The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a regularly scheduled meeting at 5:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room of the Historic Courthouse on Main Street, Hendersonville.

**PUBLIC HEARINGS**

**Rezoning Application #R-2017-04, Donald Jones**

*Commissioner Hawkins made the motion to go into public hearing for Rezoning Application #R-2017-04, Donald Jones. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

Stedman Smith, Planner, stated Rezoning Application #R-2017-04 which was initiated on June 26, 2017 at the request of applicant and agent, Mr. Donald Jones, requests the County rezone approximately 19.96 acres of land (thereafter the “Subject Area”) from Residential One (R1) zoning to Industrial (I) zoning.

The Henderson County Planning Board considered rezoning application #R-2017-04 at its regularly scheduled meetings on July 20, 2017 and August 17, 2017. During the August meeting, the Planning Board voted unanimously to send forward a favorable recommendation to rezone the Subject Area to an Industrial (I) zoning district.

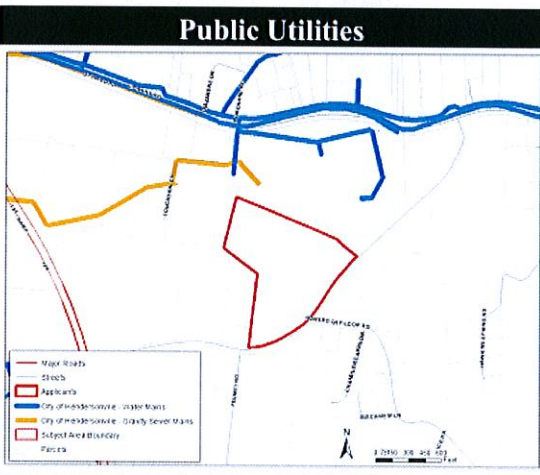
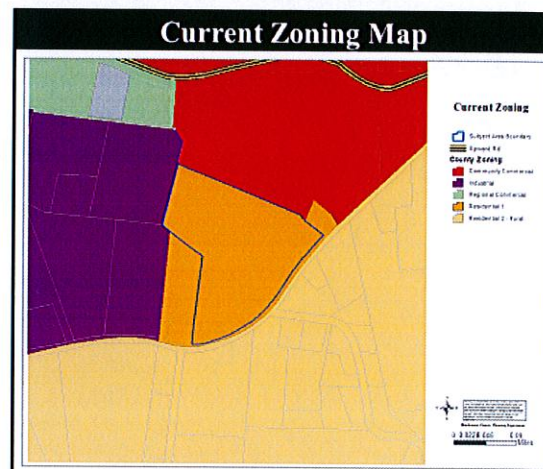
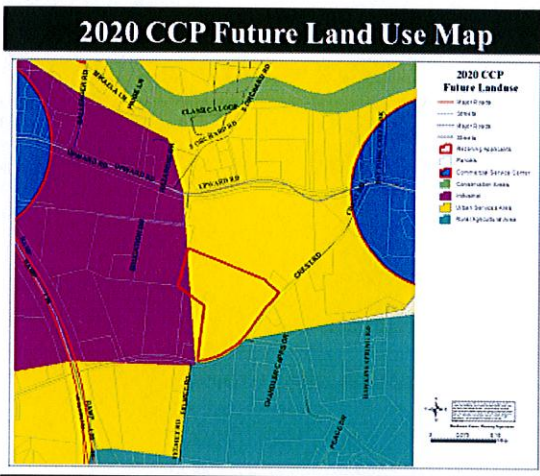
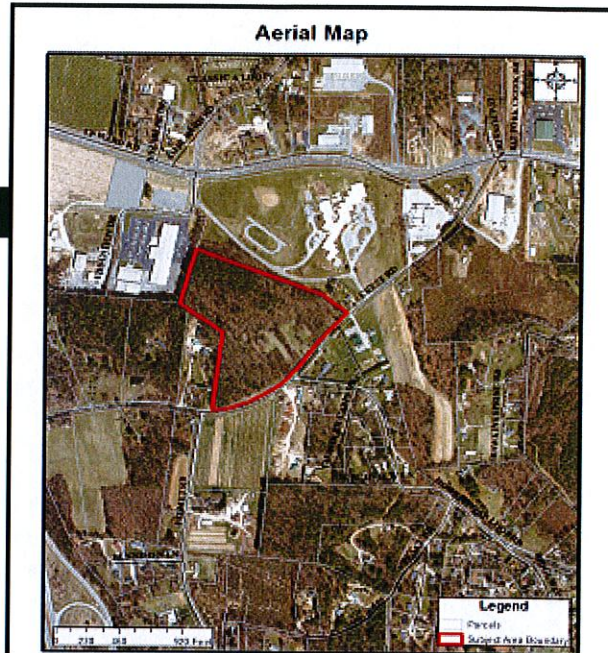
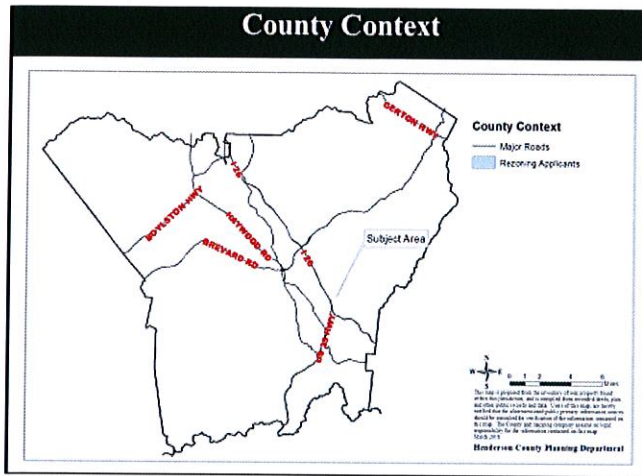
Before taking action on the application, the Board of Commissioners must hold a public hearing. In accordance with §42A-303 and §42A-346 (C) of the Henderson County Land Development Code and State Law, notices of the October 2, 2017, public hearing regarding rezoning application #R-2017-04 were published in the Times-News on September 21, 2017 and September 28, 2017. The Planning Department sent notices of the hearing via first class mail to the owners of properties adjacent to the Subject Area on September 13, 2017 and posted signs advertising the hearing on the Subject Area on September 13, 2017.

**Board Action Requested:**

If approved, State law requires that the Board adopt a written statement of consistency with the County Comprehensive Plan (CCP). A draft resolution was provided.

Public Input

There was none.

The applicant Donald Jones, informed the Board that he had already approached the school board, and an easement has been approved for connection and expansion of sewer service.

Commissioner Lapsley noted that the water line extends to the rear entrance of the school.

*Commissioner Hawkins made the motion to go out of public hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

*Commissioner Thompson made the motion that the Board adopt the resolution regarding the consistency with the CCP, and he further moved that the Board approve rezoning application #R-2017-04 to rezone the Subject Area to an Industrial (I) zoning district based on the recommendations of the Henderson County 2020 Comprehensive Plan and other supporting information. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

**Economic Development Incentives – Microtech Knives, Inc.**

*Commissioner Messer made the motion to go into public hearing regarding Economic Development Incentives for Microtech Knives, Inc. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

Brittany Brady of the Partnership for Economic Development stated a public hearing has been scheduled on 2 October 2017 in the above matter.

At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board may choose to take action, delay action to a subsequent meeting, or take no action.

Microtech Knives, Inc., is a manufacturing concern located inside Henderson County contemplating an expansion of their manufacturing operation in Henderson County. Their current location does not allow for expansion of footprint. The existing building is located inside of the Town of Fletcher. The new facility is not in the Town of Fletcher.

Under the project as proposed, the public benefit to be derived from the capital project is a total taxable capital investment by Microtech of at least \$1,100,000.00 in real property improvements (new construction), and \$1,257,000.00 in business personal property (equipment). The project would result in the creation of twenty-five (25) new jobs, at an average wage in excess of the average wage in Henderson County for full-time employment, plus other benefits. The contemplated incentives would last for a period of five (5) years. The first year's contemplated incentive, if granted, would be not more than \$9,321.94, based on the new investment, the number of new employees, and the Board's incentives guidelines. The maximum amount of incentives to be considered in this grant over the five years would be \$41,283.14.

Dan Lawson, General Manager of Microtech Knives, Inc., thanked the Board. He stated they are the producers of splendid knives and without expansion cannot keep up with the demand. These are tactical type knives sold to the military mainly but also to the public. They range in cost from \$300 - \$3,000 per knife.

Public Input

There was none.

*Commissioner Thompson made the motion to go out of public hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

*Commissioner Thompson made the motion to approve economic development incentives for five years based on the Board's incentive guidelines. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

**INFORMAL PUBLIC COMMENTS**

1. Susan Pfeiffer spoke in regard to the Eagle’s Nest. She is concerned that the Board is not following the Comprehensive Plan which calls for any development to keep the rural environment. This proposed project defies zoning and the number of units was dropped to 299 so that it would not have to go before the commissioners. Ms. Pfeiffer doesn’t feel the Etowah/Horse Shoe small area plan is being followed.
2. Mary Jane Pell feels the Comprehensive Plan is an important document and should be respected and used. Etowah is a rural community and needs to be protected. Farmland needs to be protected. Their roads are narrow, winding, and already have too much traffic.
3. Ed Dowd spoke on behalf of the Etowah’s Reach Homeowner’s Association. They oppose the Eagles’ Nest, and feel there is no infrastructure to support the new development. The businesses located within the Eagle’s Nest do not fit into the R1 zoning.
4. Ward Seguin does not feel that the Eagle’s Nest proposal fits the Comprehensive Plan. He is concerned about water, sewer, congestion, farmland, etc. If the Eagle’s Nest does their own facilities, will they maintain them? Is this a done deal? If not, what can they do?
5. Russell Williams moved to Etowah for the rural environment. He is against the Eagle’s Nest project. He would like to continue living in a quiet area.

*Commissioner Hawkins made the motion to approve the Consent Agenda with the addition of the Request from Buncombe County to remove the deed restriction to the Bent Creek property. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

Attorney Russ Burrell received an email from Buncombe County’s attorney asking the Board of Commissioners (Henderson County) to release the condition (regarding use for economic development purposes) on the conveyance of the “Bent Creek property”. Topography is bad. The property will be rezoned to residential if the restriction is removed.

### **County Financial Report/Cash Balance Report**

The August 2017 County Financial Report and Cash Balance Report were provided for the Board's review and approval.

The following are explanations for departments/programs with higher budget to actual percentages for the month of August:

- Non-Profit Contributions – payment of 1<sup>st</sup> quarter Board approved non-profit contributions to agencies
- Garage – purchase/encumbrance of two new fleet replacement vehicles approved in the budget
- Information Technology – payment of annual software/hardware support maintenance contracts
- EMS – purchase/encumbrance of three new replacement ambulances approved in the budget
- Mental Health – 1<sup>st</sup> quarter Maintenance of Effort (MOE) funding payment to Vaya Health

The YTD deficit in the Revaluation Reserve Fund is due to the purchase/encumbrance of two new replacement vehicles approved in the budget.

The YTD deficit in the Edneyville Elementary School, the Hendersonville High School and the Law Enforcement Training Center (LETC) Projects is due to the payment of architect fees for these projects from appropriated fund balance in the Capital Projects Funds that will be reimbursed from future financings.

The YTD deficits in the Recreation Parks Improvements Projects and the Artificial Turf Field Projects is due to these projects being paid from appropriated fund balance in the Capital Projects Fund primarily from proceeds received from the sale of the Bent Creek property as approved in the prior year's budget.

The YTD deficit in the Cane Creek Water & Sewer District Fund is due to final sewer capital project expenditure payments in August on the Mill Pond Creek Sewer Project, which has been completed. Fund Balance in the Cane Creek Fund was appropriated in the approved budget to cover these capital project expenditures.

### **Energy & Fuel Management Update for FY 16-17**

This report details the County's use of energy and fuel during FY 2016-2017. Considered in this report are most general fund departments, three enterprise funds, and several departments or organizations that receive some form of reimbursement.



The data in this report serve three purposes: to juxtapose budgets versus actuals of fuel and energy dollars, compare this past fiscal year with FY 15-16 to create trends and understand patterns of usage, and to outline energy and fuel efficiency projects and opportunities for better annual management of resources and future improvements.

**Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) Request by NCDOT**

At September 20, 2017, Board of Commissioners Meeting, staff presented a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) submitted by North Carolina Department of Transportation (NC DOT). This CLOMR was to replace an existing bridge on Hooper Lane located in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) on the border of Henderson County and the Town of Mills River. Henderson County is required to sign a community acknowledgment agreeing or disagreeing with the project. The majority of the affected properties are within the Town of Mills River jurisdiction. The Board directed staff to meet with Town of Mills River and see if they have concerns regarding the CLOMR as submitted.

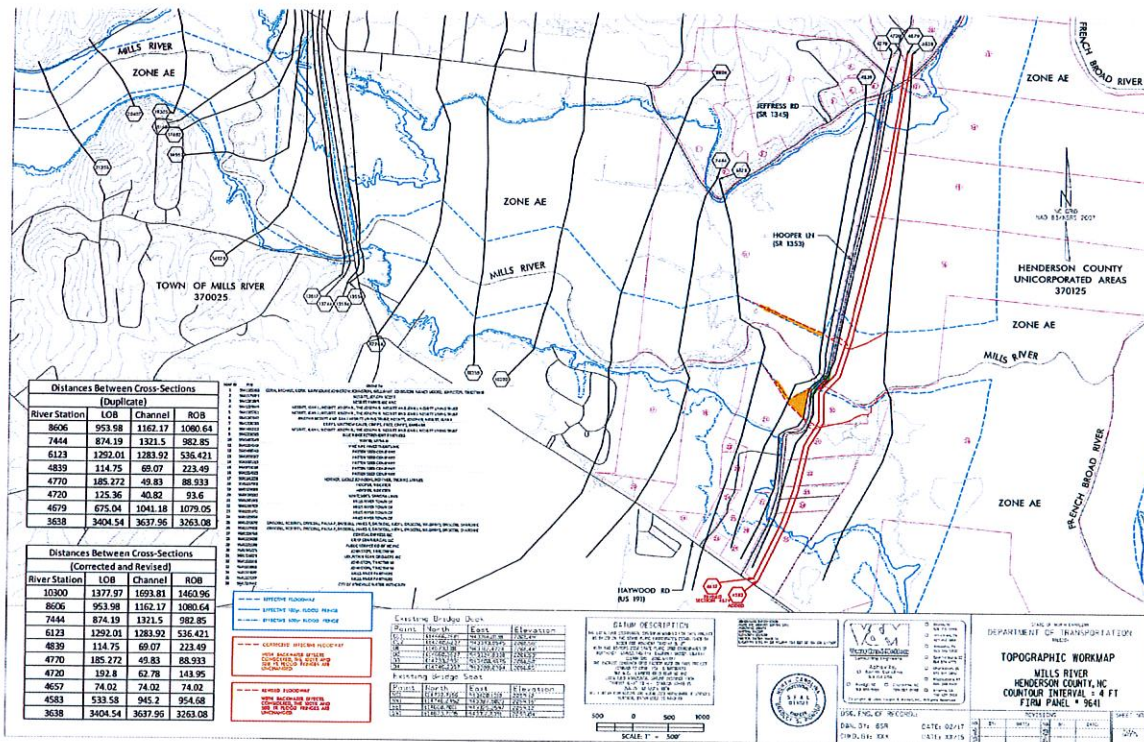
Staff met with Town Manager Jeff Wells and Councilman Wayne Carland on September 21st. Town of Mills River staff requested our assistance in discussing their concerns with NC DOT hydraulics engineer.

NC DOT revised the CLOMR for the bridge replacement after our discussions. Two parcels of land are affected by the rise in flood waters, they both are in the Town of Mills River, and both are in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) (See map below).

Town of Mills River staff is in agreement with the revised CLOMR.

**HENDERSON COUNTY WATER AND SEWER ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Pursuant to ongoing discussions between the City of Hendersonville and Henderson County regarding representation in the provisions of utilities, the City Council has reinstated the Henderson County Water and Sewer Advisory Committee.

The City of Hendersonville has asked that Henderson County appoint one sitting Commissioner, and one utility customer that resides in an unincorporated area of Henderson County to this committee, and forward those names to the City Clerk by Monday, October 16, 2017.

Commissioner Lapsley stated he appreciates the City reviving this committee. He is however, concerned about the Rules of Procedures, Article II, Purposes and Powers. Reference is only made to the Cane Creek Water and Sewer District area and should be the entire county.



Article II states the Board will review and make recommendations on water and sewer. This is an advisory committee and does not have such authority. The review should be done by all Governing Bodies over the area.

In Article III, it states they meet twice per year. Mr. Lapsley does not feel this is adequate. The Chair can call a special meeting and this should happen every month if they are doing their job. The Chair determines the agenda and Mr. Lapsley feels this is not good enough.

Article III states they will hold public hearings, when this committee does not have any authority to hold a public hearing. It is an advisory committee only. No binding decisions can be made.

Mr. Lapsley feels if we participate, we should not expect a great deal.

It was the consensus of the Board that the City needs to look at the governance and authority of the committee to set rates. The unincorporated areas need more voice.

*Commissioner Thompson made the motion that the Board appoint William Lapsley as the commissioner appointee. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

Staff will do a press release for the utility customer residing in an unincorporated area of Henderson County position.

#### **PARTNERSHIP FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING**

Penny Summey, DSS Board Chair, stated the Department of Social Services is providing informational updates to the Board of Commissioners regarding various Social Services issues. The October 2017 update, provided by DSS Board Chair Penny Summey, is an informational presentation regarding the Partnership for Independent Living; an on-going collaboration between the Department of Social Services and the Council on Aging.

In 2005 the Council on Aging for Henderson County (COA) and the Henderson County Department of Social Services (DSS) started a private and public collaborative program that shares the mission of delaying or preventing out-of-home placement of seniors. This collaborative is known as the Partnership for Independent Living (PFIL). Other goals of the Partnership include reducing private and public costs, maximizing the use of limited private and public revenues, and placing a high value on a person's choice and right to self-determination. DSS contributes four social work staff and COA contributes two social work staff to the Partnership. The social workers provide case management services to 25 to 30 adults each. Social workers arrange and coordinate a wide variety of in-home and supportive services including home health, meals on wheels, adult day care, home modifications/ improvements, lifeline services, in-home aide services, transportation access, and the list goes on. The assigned social worker makes at least monthly contact with each adult to assess and monitor the adults' needs and make any referrals that will help the adult to remain safely in his or her home.

At the inception of the Partnership it was found that the two agencies were unknowingly duplicating services to clients. One of the first goals of the Partnership was to eliminate this duplication. Well organized efforts and close communication between COA and DSS soon resolved this issue and resulted in better and more coordinated services to the clients.

In 2011 a registered nurse was added to the Partnership to provide health support services. Health support services offer a limited number of slots to PFIL clients to provide medication management, client education, and advocacy. The RN works closely with medical providers and pharmacies to ensure successful medication reconciliation and to support the client to properly take prescribed medications. In addition, the RN and social worker coordinate to develop a plan of care with the client. The goal is to monitor the adult's ability to understand the prescribed medications and how to take them effectively.

Last year the Partnership served an average of 181 clients per month. Currently 175 clients are being served by the program. Seventy five referrals were made to the program last year with 36 new clients being added. Referrals are made by physicians, hospitals, home health agencies, other non-profits as well as friends and relatives of seniors in the community.

In discussing the Partnership, Trina Stokes, the Director of the Council on Aging, stated "The Partnership for Independent Living is a unique collaboration between two like-minded organizations. Both DSS and COA are passionate about coordinating local resources to ensure older adults have the necessary tools to remain living independent, safely. Both agencies work hard to ensure client's right to self-determination is protected while opening their mind to opportunities and resources that enhance their quality of life. Henderson County residents are lucky to have two agencies that work so well together to provide this unique service to seniors." #### **SCHEDULE A PUBLIC INPUT SESSION ON EDNEYVILLE SEWER OPTIONS**

Steve Wyatt stated at the Board's September 20, 2017 meeting, there was additional discussion of sewer options for Edneyville Elementary. Following that discussion, the Board directed Staff to determine a date, time and place for a public input session in the Edneyville area. Staff recommends the Board schedule the meeting for Thursday, October 19, 2017 at 6:00pm at the North Henderson High School Auditorium.

*Commissioner Thompson made the motion that the Board schedules a Public Input Session on Edneyville Sewer Options for Thursday, October 19, 2017 at 6:00pm, at the North Henderson High School Auditorium. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

#### **EDNEYVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

John Mitchell, Business and Community Development Director, stated at the August 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Commissioners, the Board accepted the design for a new Edneyville Elementary School, and directed staff to proceed with the project.

Staff convened a committee to select a Construction Manager at Risk to complete the project. Clark Nexsen received Request for Qualifications statements from applicants until August 9<sup>th</sup> and the committee interviewed potential firms on September 12<sup>th</sup>.

After a pre-selection process, three potential firms were interviewed. The potential firms were scored on a 100 point scale utilizing a Prequalification Ratings Matrix. After a tally of the scores, Beverly Grant/Barnhill was selected as the committee's recommendation for the Construction Manager at Risk for the Edneyville Elementary School Project.

August 1, 2019 is the projected completion date.

*Commissioner Hawkins made the motion that the Board accepts Beverly Grant/Barnhill as the Construction Manager at Risk for the Edneyville Elementary project. All voted in favor and the motion carried.*

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Director and Planning Board provided recommendations regarding the proposed zoning map amendment with case #R-2017-04; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.C. General Statute §153-323, the Planning Director provided the prescribed public notice and the Board held the required public hearing on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017; and


**WHEREAS**, N.C. General Statute §153-341 requires the Board to adopt a statement of consistency with the County Comprehensive Plan (CCP); and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners as follows:


1. That the Board reviewed the proposed map amendment (#R-2017-04 applicant/agent Mr. Donald Jones) and finds that it is reasonable, in the public interest and it is consistent with the CCP and the Growth Management Strategy located therein; and
2. That the Board determines that the proposed map amendment provides for the sound administration of the LDC while balancing property rights and promoting reasonable growth within the County; and
3. That this Resolution shall be retained in the Office of the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners.

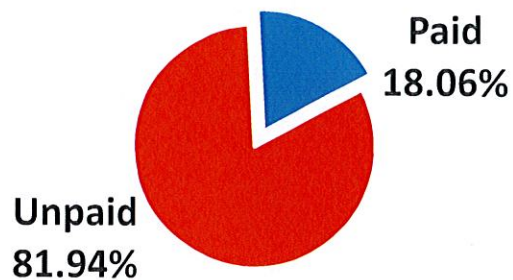

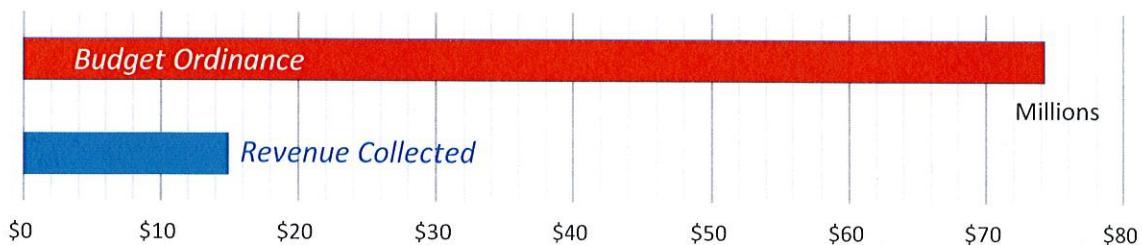
