



# French Broad River MPO - Planning Funds

- FBRMPO currently has a call for project for planning funds
- Approximately \$90,000 are available
- Applications are due December 31st
- Requires a 20% local match based on the total project cost
- Feasibility study for a greenway along this portion of Mud Creek would cost approximately \$50,000
  - Requested funding would be \$40,000
  - Required local match would be \$10,000
- Funding would not be available until FY 2019

#### **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:**

Blue Ridge Humane Society obtained title to two tracts in late 2016. One parcel (10000466) was vacant during 2017, and the other (10000465) was partially used by the Society for tax-exempt purposes. Only property actually used for exempt purposes is not taxed for *ad valorem* property tax purposes. The portion of the property used for tax-exempt purposes is valued as follows:

Building Value	\$64,500
Land Value	\$152,460
Misc. Improvement Value	\$6,500
(Asphalt Paving)	
Total Exempt	\$223,460

This amount is out of a total value for parcel 10000465 of \$750,400. It is proposed that a release of obligations for the 2017 tax year be granted for the portion of parcel 10000465 as stated above, and that the status (taxable) for parcel 10000466 be unchanged. Releases for exemption must be granted, if at all, before the end of the tax year. Blue Ridge Humane Society is in agreement with this proposal.

County staff will be present and prepared if requested to give further information on this matter.

BOARD ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the partial exemption.

If the Board is so inclined, the following motion is suggested:

I move that the Board grant the release of \$223,460 of the value of parcel 10000465 for tax year 2017, as qualifying as exempt from taxation.
