


PUBLIC COMMENT SIGNUP SHEET



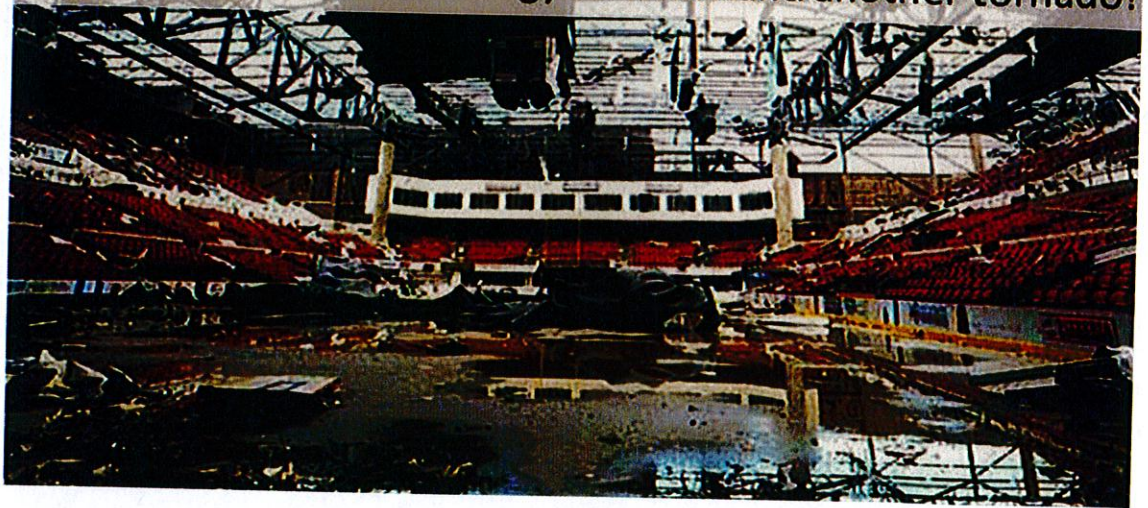


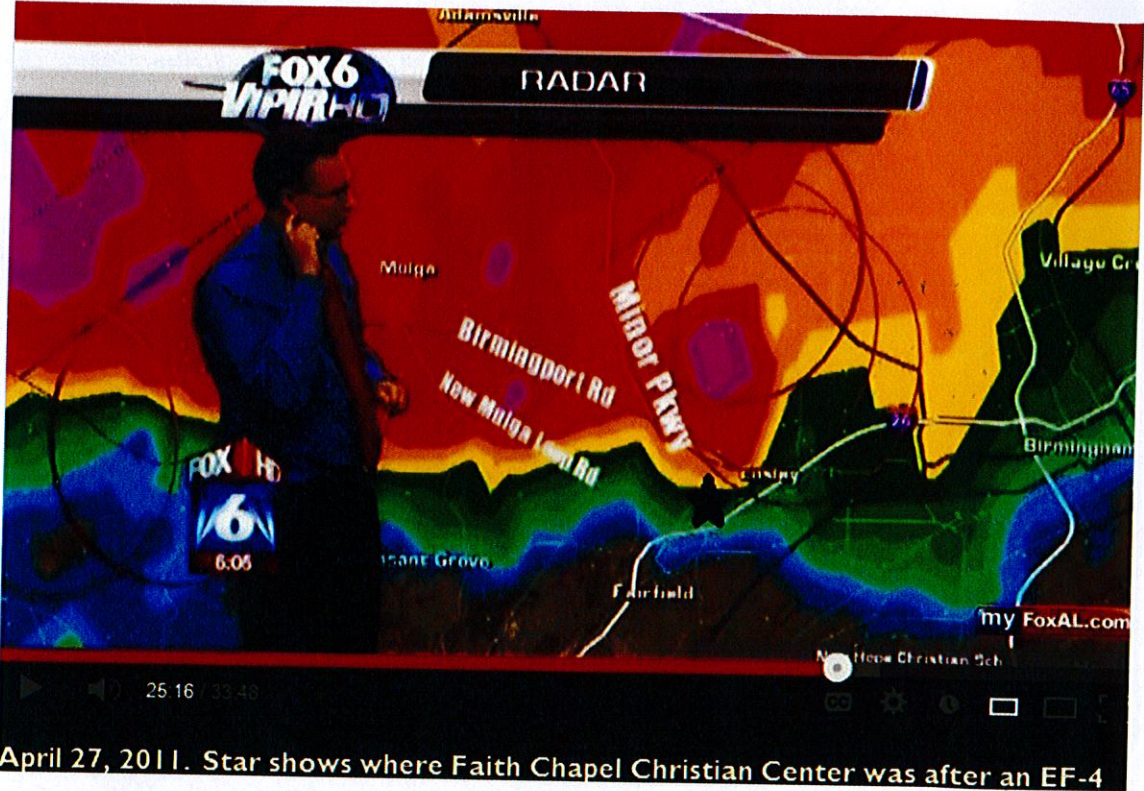




This 12,000-seat facility hosted an indoor football game one night earlier, with over 7,000 attending. It also hosts Montana Fair

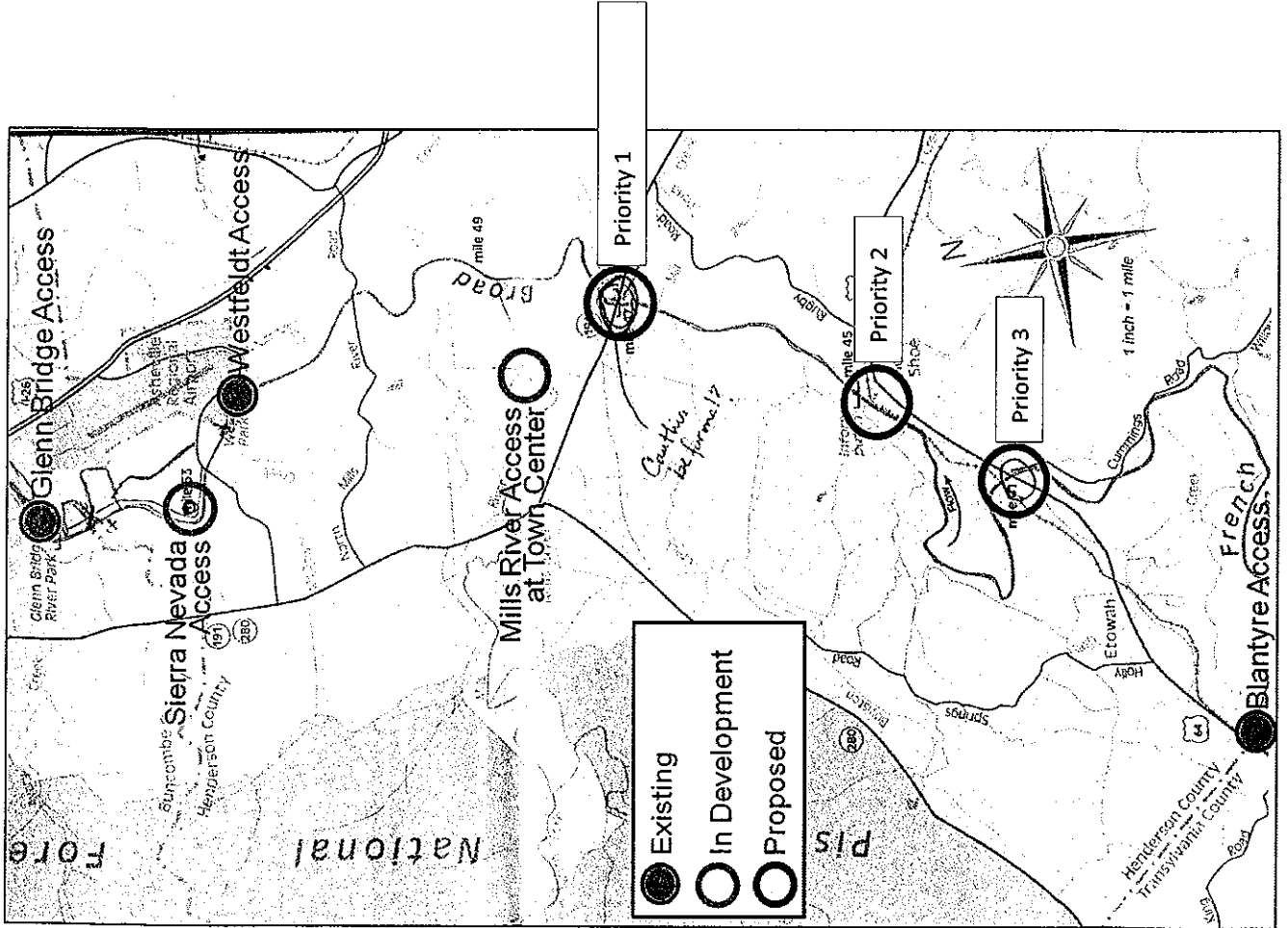

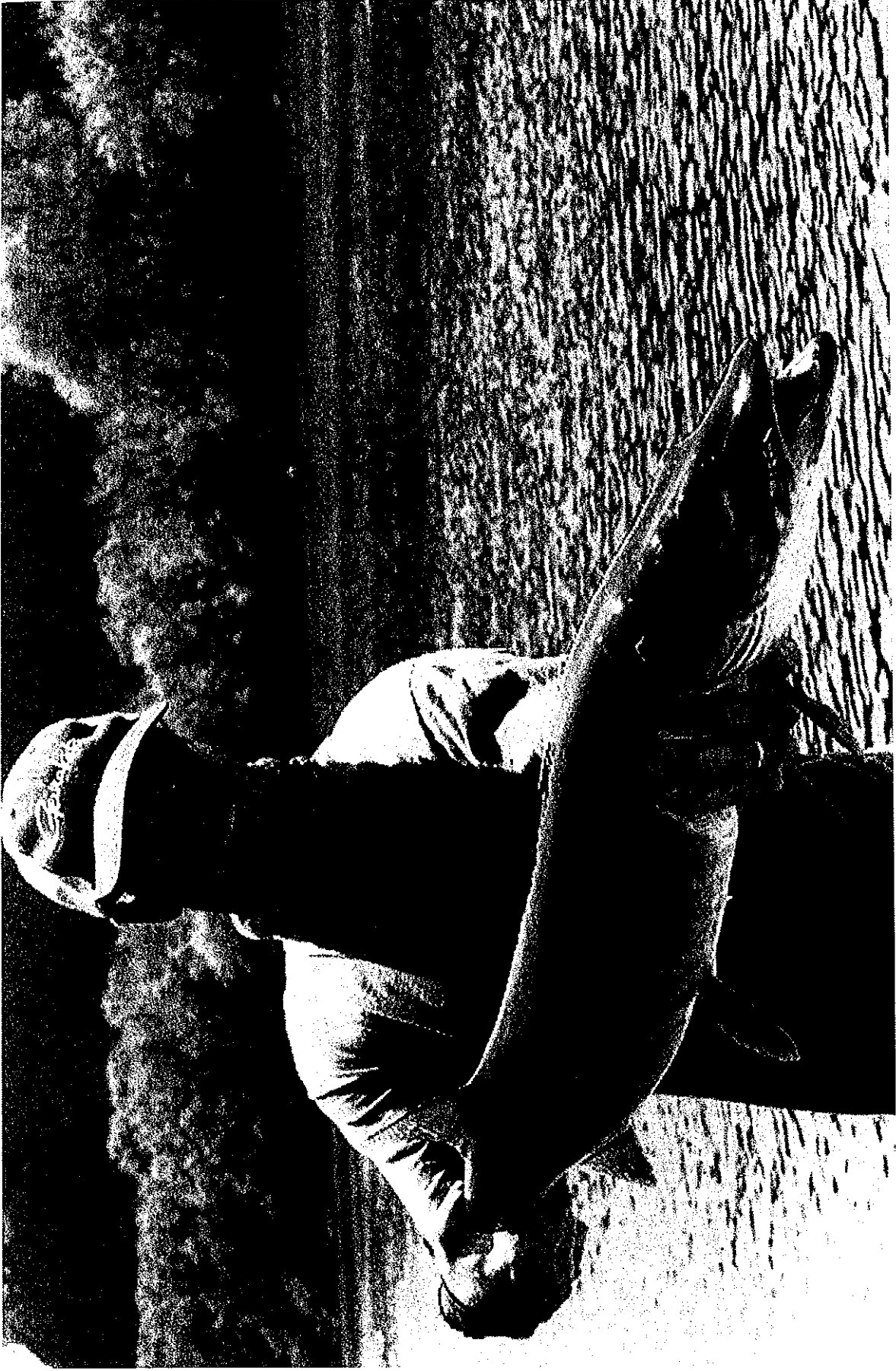

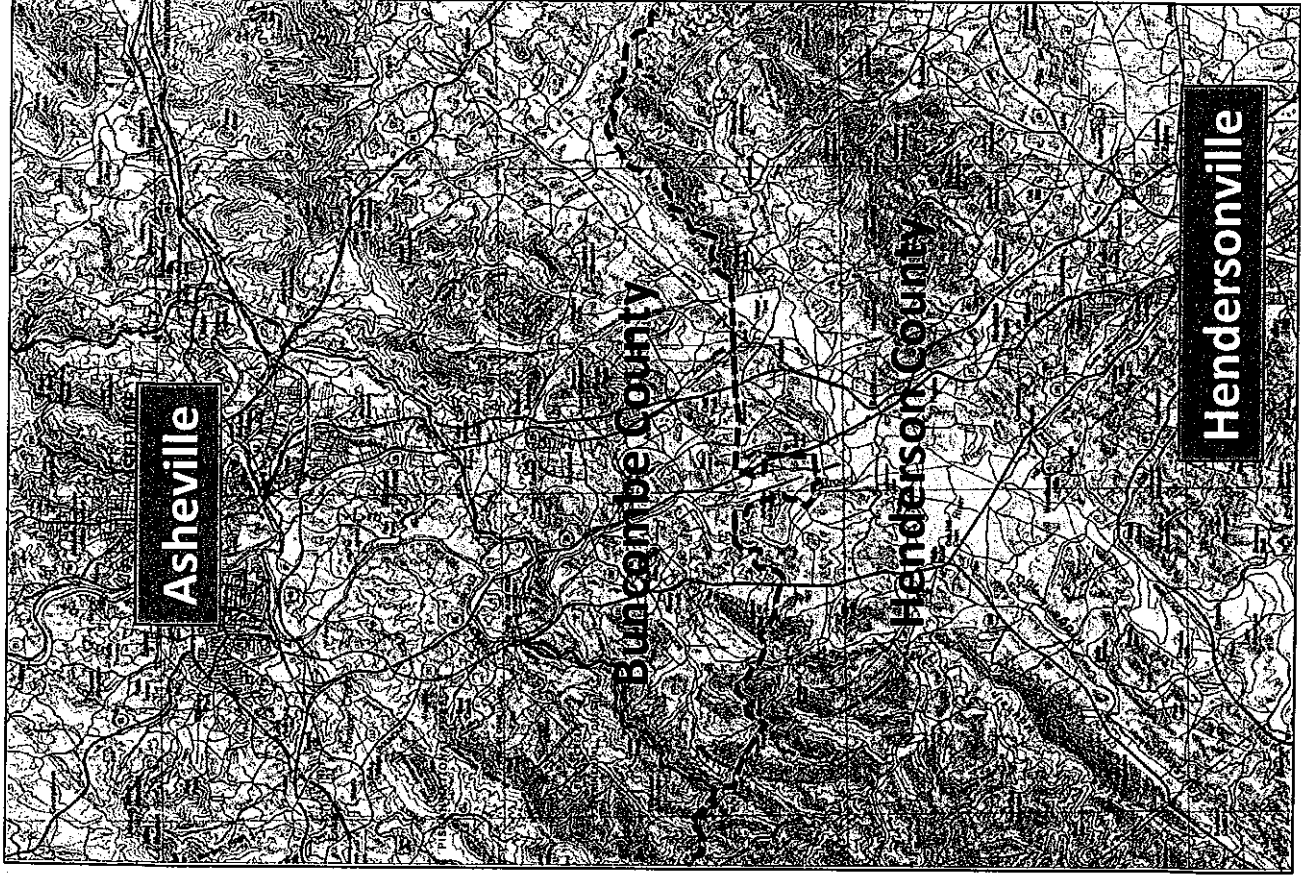

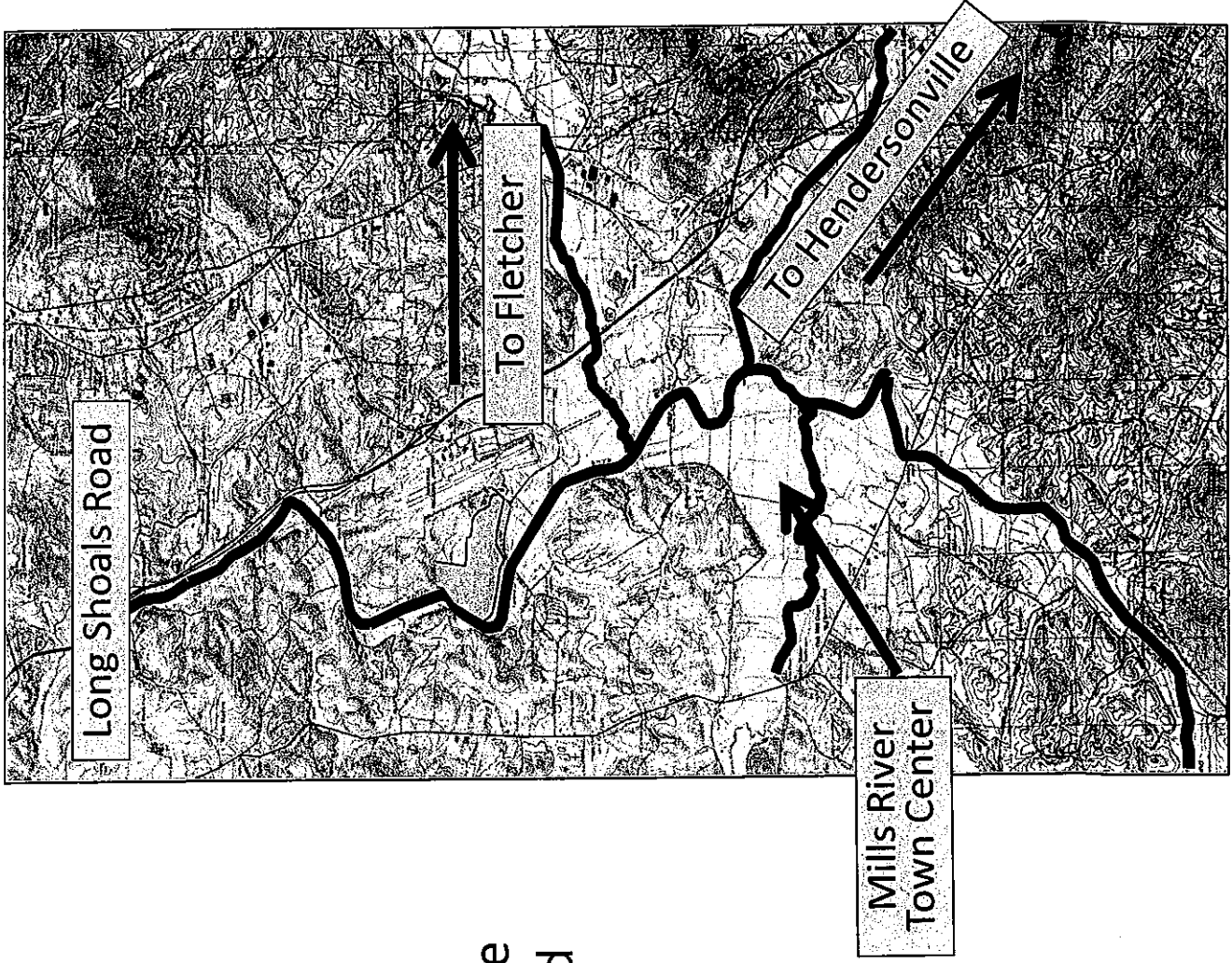
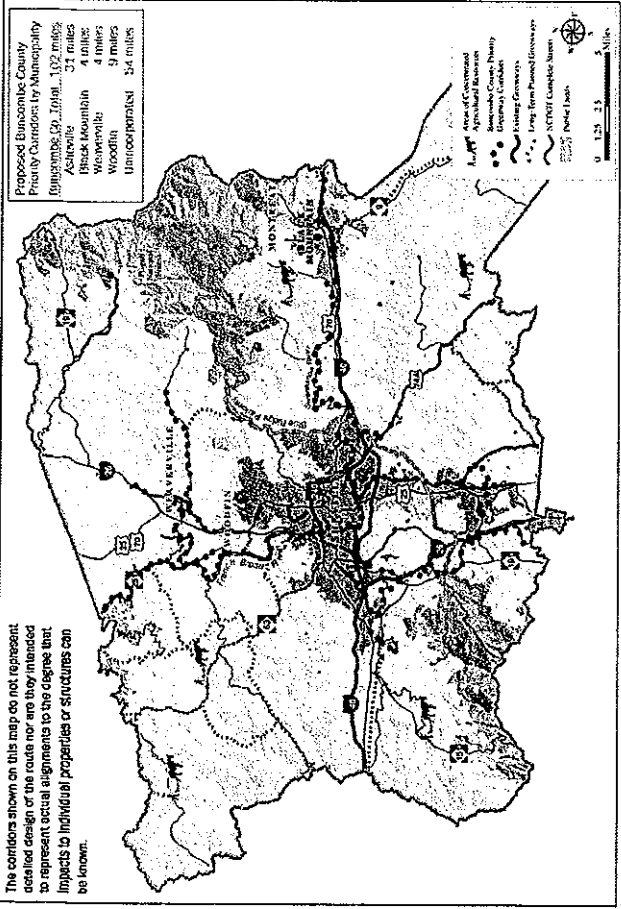




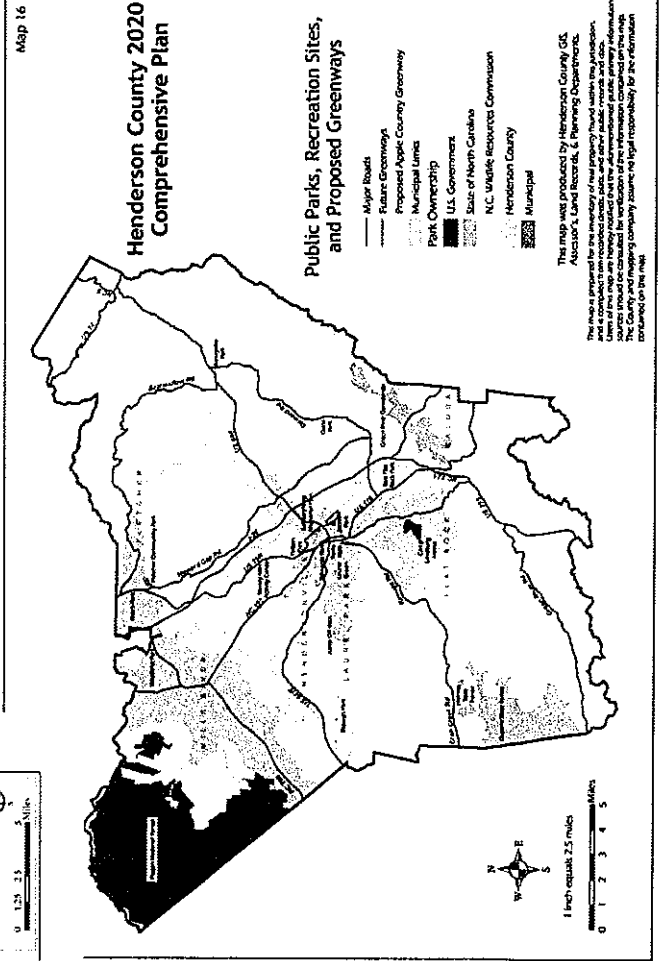
Exhibit 3-2: Buncombe County Greenways & Trails Overview

GREENWAYS: Buncombe and Henderson Counties have Adopted Greenway Master Plans that Follow the French Broad River Corridor

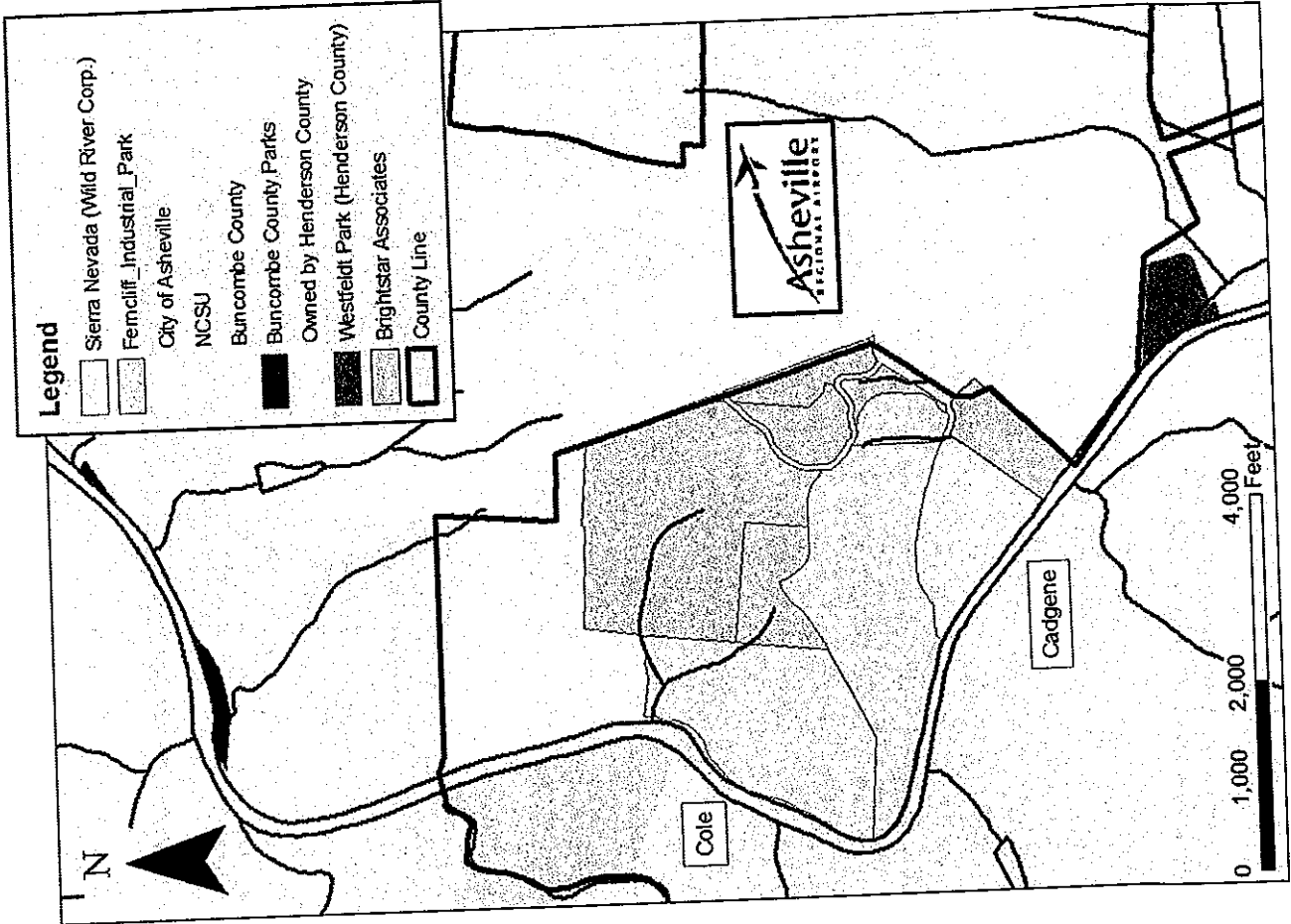

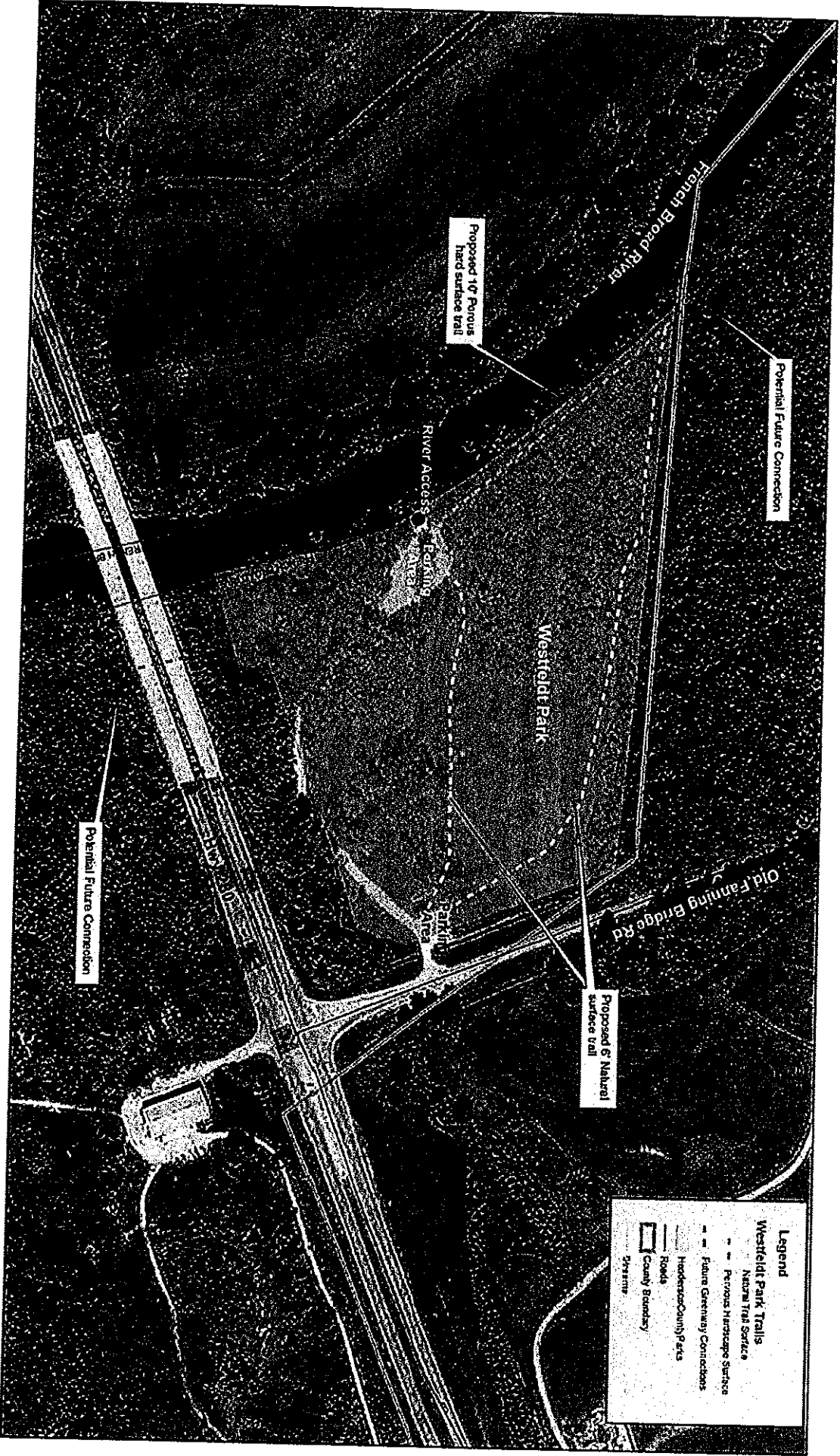
