

Funding for the following capital projects was requested in 2010-11, but was not received, or only partially received. In addition to new needs, we request that these projects be reconsidered for 2011-12:

- \$32,000 for carpet replacement in the Patton Building; of the \$50,000 requested in 2010-11, only \$18,000 was received.
- \$15,000 for air-lock partitions in the Patton Building lobby.
- \$5,000 for a concrete ceiling over the storage room in the Motorcycle/Pottery Building, where BLET weapons are stored.
- \$12,500 for flag pole lighting.
- \$300,000 for a parking lot addition for TEDC and ISC.
- \$26,000 for a hybrid car to replace the high miles Ford Explorer.

PARTITIONS FOR ENERGY SAVINGS

PURPOSE: When this building was built, the design did not include air locks for the lobby. The lobby is extremely cold in the winter, and in the fall the lobby floor is covered in leaves blown in by the wind. Air lock partitions at each front entrance will help keep the lobby at a comfortable temperature and keep the leaves out, as well as protect the lobby and our customers from the rain.

REPLACE EXTERIOR DOORS / BACK SIDE OF LOBBY

PURPOSE: With the partitions to be installed on the front side of the lobby, it makes sense to replace the existing doors on the back that are worn out, have lock issues, and need to be upgraded to save energy.

STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011.

COST: \$15,000.00

REPLACE EXTERIOR & INTERIOR DOORS

PURPOSE: The doors are worn out from years of use by faculty, staff and students. **STATUS**: To be completed over the summer

of 2011.

COST: \$10,000.00



REPLACE HARDWARE AND LOCKS (UPSTAIRS CLASSROOMS)

PURPOSE: The locks are about 40 years old, some don't even lock. We have had a lot of problems with them this past year.

STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011

COST: \$5,500.00

KEYLESS/WIRELESS SECURITY SYSTEM

PURPOSE: This system can lock down the building for an emergency reason and automatically lock the building down each evening. The programmable system allows you to customize access as necessary and to identify past access by person and time.

STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011

COST: \$9,000.00


CARPET/TILE REPLACEMENT

PURPOSE: The building was built in 1973; tile was installed originally, and over time was replaced with carpet. Several high-traffic areas still need to be replaced, including the multi-purpose room, some classrooms, and office space.

STATUS: To be completed over winter break 2011.

COST: \$32,000.00





INSTALL ROOF AND FENCE, WITH WALL AROUND GAS TANKS

PURPOSE: The walls are to be installed in case of a leak from the tanks, and are required for safety reasons. The fence would prevent theft and the roof would provide protection of the pump handles from ice and snow and protection from the weather for personnel.

STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011.

EMERGENCY ANNOUNCEMENT SYSTEM

PURPOSE: Mass notification system for A&S and the surrounding area, for safety reasons. The hardware includes interior and exterior speakers to be heard by students, faculty, staff and guests.

COST: \$7,800.00

CARPET REPLACEMENT

PURPOSE: This building is another one that had some replacement of carpet 15 to 20 years ago.

Carpet is well used and worn from high traffic.

STATUS: To be completed over winter break 2011.

ADD AUDIO TO ELEVATOR

PURPOSE: The emergency telephone is unreliable and needs to be upgraded.

STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011.

COST: \$5,000.00

RENOVATE OLD KITCHEN FOR WORKSPACE & STORAGE, REWORK RESTROOMS

PURPOSE: The present kitchen area can be changed to needed work space for the staff in the CE building. Because more women than men seem to use the 1st floor bathrooms, we would like to make the **present men's** restroom a **women's** restroom and vice versa. This will provide more stalls for the women.

KEYLESS/WIRELESS SECURITY SYSTEM

PURPOSE: Early College is housed in this building. At the present time we have the keyless security system in the weight room, and we want to expand the system to the rest of the building.

GROUNDSKEEPING BUILDING

WATERPROOFING AND EXTERIOR DRAINAGE

PURPOSE: The building is located on the back side of the dam, and there are springs and water seepages that penetrate around the perimeter of the building. When the ground is saturated, the water has no place to go except inside the building.

MOTORCYCLE/POTTERY BUILDING

UPGRADE CEILING OVER WEAPONS STORAGE AREA

PURPOSE: In order to prevent access by unauthorized persons to the equipment in this room, we

want to pour a concrete ceiling.

COST: \$5,000.00

A.D.A. COMPLIANCE, TOILETS & FIXTURES

PURPOSE: Bathrooms outdated. ADA compliant fixtures need to be installed.

STATUS: To be completed over summer of 2011

COST: \$5,500.00



SPEARMAN BUILDING

NEW AIR COMPRESSOR

PURPOSE: The existing compressor is being used more and more by the shops, and quite a number of repairs were required in the last two years. According to the manufacturer, the life expectancy of the current unit is five years under normal use. The unit will be five years old in 2012.

STATUS: To be completed over the summer of 2011.

COST: \$21,200.00

RENOVATION TO ADD BOOTHS IN WELDING LAB

STATUS: To be completed over winter break 2011.



STATUS: To be completed in the summer of 2011.



1992 PICKUP TRUCK REPLACEMENT


PURPOSE: This truck is 18 years old with 102,000 miles (non-highway). We want to replace it with a
