BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
June 25, 1996

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a special called meeting at noon in the Commissioners' Conference Room of the Henderson County Office Building.

Those present were: Chairman Renee Kumor, Vice-Chair Vollie G. Good, Commissioner J. Michael Edney, Commissioner Bob Eklund, Commissioner Don Ward, and County Manager David E. Nicholson.

Also present were: Finance Director J. Carey McLelland and Budget Analyst Selena Coffey.

FY 1996-1997

David Nicholson discussed with the Board the following:

Special School Tax District Fund
Revaluation Reserve Fund
Travel & Tourism Fund
Soil & Water District Fund
E-911 Fund
Economic Development Fund
Debt Services Fund
Mud Creek Water & Sewer District Fund
Capital Building Fund

The Board revisited major issues from the General Fund, such as:
 Dispatch personnel
 COPS Grant
 Replacement of Vehicles
 Education
 Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

The Board discussed the need to have funds available for several projects included in the Capital Improvements Program. These projects included the Edneyville Library, Etowah Recreation Park, East Flat Rock Park and a future park located in Tuxedo. The County Manager had presented a senario that included a one cent tax increase to fund these projects. The consensus of the Board was to approve a one cent increase for the CIP.

June 25, 1996

The Board directed staff to develop several restrictions within the Budget Ordinance. These included that county funds would be used to fund the 5% supplement for all persons paid through the State Teacher's Salary Scale and for Teacher's Assistants. No county funds may be used for any supplement for Principals, Assistant Principals or system-wide Administrators. These restrictions apply also to Instructional Personnel and Non-Instructional Personnel at Blue Ridge Community College.

The Board also approved the funding of schools on an as-needed basis.

CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner Edney made the motion for the Board to go into Closed Session as allowed under NCGS 143-318.11 (a)(6) To consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment, or conditions of initial employment of an individual public officer or employee or prospecti8ve public officer or employee; or to hear or investigate a complaint, charge, or grievance by or against an individual public officer or employee.

The motion carried four to one with Commissioner Ward voting nay.

Commissioner Edney made the motion for the Board to go out of Closed Session. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

ACTION FOLLOWING CLOSED SESSION

Commssioner Eklund made the motion to approve the FY 1996-1997 Budget as amended by the Board and to direct staff to develope the Budget Ordinance based on the Board's directives for the Chairman's signature.

The motion carried four to one with Commissioner Ward voting nay.
