


PUBLIC COMMENT SIGNUP SHEET



Subject: NCDOT Kanuga Improvement Project# R-5748

As an owner and officer of the following businesses and properties directly affected by this this project my concerns are as follows:

Norm's Minit Mart, 806 Kanuga Road

Norm's Minit Wash, 713 Kanuga Road

Hendersonville City Council's decision to ignore thousands of signatures on a petition against a roundabout on Kanuga Road will result in the loss of our Minit Wash location of 16 years. With only three businesses remaining in our company, it becomes very important that we preserve the integrity of ingress and egress at our store, 806 Kanuga Road, in order to remain viable as a corporate entity.

Losing the current red light access from Hebron will negatively affect this business. Losing ease of access to Kanuga Road may destroy it. Removing the traffic signal from the Hebron and Kanuga intersection in favor of a roundabout to join with White Street will seriously impede customer and vendor access.

I ask that the ability to make a left turn from Hebron Street, alongside my store, onto Kanuga Road, be preserved as an egress point for my customers and vendors. I also ask that the ability to turn left onto Hebron, alongside my store, be preserved by eliminating the concrete center median being proposed for the middle of Kanuga Road. Ingress and egress from Kanuga Road, onto Hebron, alongside the store, should be preserved to maintain some level of access along that route, which merges into Yarborough Street and rejoins White Street, for the sake of existing and future businesses.

I would further ask that the current open curb cut across the front of Norm's Minit Mart be maintained in order to facilitate the current access required by our eighteen-wheeled tractor trailer fuel, grocery and beverage delivery trucks. Ingress and egress for deliveries, while maintaining enough room for customer vehicles of all types is critical to our store remaining "convenient" and relevant to its very purpose.

Our business currently serves approximately 1,200 to 1,400 customers per day. We receive 12-14 tractor trailer and 20-24 box truck deliveries per week. Please remember that if we fail to be convenient to our customers, they will go elsewhere. Norm's Minit Mart has proudly served our community for 36 years and provided jobs to many long-term employees, who like our many of our customers, feel like family.

The influence that you have on these road projects is great and it is our hope that you can see the benefits of minimizing the damage to all of the businesses along the Kanuga corridor.
