The Henderson County Sheriff's Office requests that the service badge and sidearm of Master Deputy Lorie Levi be given to her in recognition of her retirement from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office.

Master Deputy Lorie Levi began employment with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on August 1, 1988 through December 4, 1994 and returned to employment with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on October 2, 2001 and held the ranks of Detention Officer, Deputy, Senior Deputy, Master Deputy, and Corporal. Master Deputy Levi has served for over 24 years in the Sheriff's Office. She has spent her adult life serving our community and agency. To honor her and show my gratitude, the Sheriff's Office intends to present her service badge and service sidearm to her.

Sheriff Lowell S. Griffin makes this request on behalf of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 20-187.2(a).

Resolution Honoring Master Deputy Lorie Levi



For 30 Years of Law Enforcement Service and Awarding Her Badge and Sidearm to Her

WHEREAS, Master Deputy Lorie Levi joined the Henderson County Sheriff's Office as a benefit-eligible employee and served between August 1, 1988 through December 4, 1994 and returned to employment with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office as a benefit-eligible Detention Officer on October 1, 2001 and held the ranks of Detention Officer, Deputy, Senior Deputy, Master Deputy, and Corporal; and

WHEREAS, Master Deputy Levi's service and dedication to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office and service, dedication and accomplishments in the field of law enforcement during her 30 years of service are hereby recognized and commended; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 provides that retiring officers of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office may receive, at the time of their retirement, the badge worn or carried by them during their service with Henderson County; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 further provides that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners may, in its discretion, award to a retiring officer the service sidearm of such retiring officer at a price determined by the Board of Commissioners, upon securing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. 14-402 et seq; and

WHEREAS, Master Deputy Levi has served as a member of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office for a period of 24 years and retired from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on August 31, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. Sheriff Lowell Griffin is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Master Deputy Levi the badge worn by her during her service with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office; and
2. Sheriff Griffin is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Master Deputy Levi her service sidearm at no cost to the officer and upon her securing a permit required by N.C.G.S. 14-402.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners recognizes and thanks Master Deputy Levi for her dedicated service to Henderson County and its citizens.
