SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

The Home & Community Care Block Grant is a State/Federal program administered at the local level. Each year, the Board of Commissioners is required to adopt a Funding Plan for the Home & Community Care Block Grant for Older Adults and identify the lead office or agency responsible for coordinating the County Funding Plan.

The Home & Community Care Block Grant funding amount for FY25 is \$863,502. This is an increase of \$19,209 from FY24. The proposed Funding Plan supports the service priorities identified for the current planning cycle.

Staff recommend designation of the County Manager's office as the Lead Agency or office and approval of the proposed FY25 Funding Plan as presented.
