

PROCLAMATION OF A COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY


- Section 1. Pursuant to §76-10 *et seq.* of the Henderson County Code (“the Code”), and to the applicable provisions of the North Carolina General Statutes (including but not limited to Chapter 166A and Article 36A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes), I have determined that a state of emergency pursuant to §76-10 exists in Henderson County, based on the approach and potential impacts from Hurricane Helene.
- Section 2. I, therefore, proclaim the existence of a state of emergency in Henderson County.
- Section 3. A state of emergency is also proclaimed, at the request of the Mayors, in the Town of Fletcher, Town of Laurel Park, Village of Flat Rock and Town of Mills River.
- Section 4. I hereby order all county law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to my control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable ordinances, state and federal laws and the Henderson County Emergency Operations Plan.
- Section 5. Duration of Proclamation. This proclamation shall be in full force and effect from 8:00am on Thursday September 26, 2024, until modified or rescinded by order or operation of law.
- Section 6. A copy of this proclamation shall be posted at the Henderson County Courthouse, at the County Commissioner notice board, on the Henderson County website, and shall be distributed to all mass media outlets serving Henderson County and to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.
