The Board of Elections met November 15, 2024, at 11:00 AM at the Henderson County Board of Elections office at 75 E. Central Street. Members present were Clay Eddleman, Chair, Debbie Dante, Secretary, Linda Rebuck, Sharon Pearson, Cindy Ellis, Members, and Summer Heatherly, Director. Staff present: Aaron, Chasity, Mary K.

Pledge

Agenda: Chair recommended moving the 3rd entry on the agenda – *Tabulate and add results for write-ins* – to below *Review, tabulate, and add results of approved Supplemental Absentee Ballots*. Member Rebuck moved to approve agenda as recommended. Member Pearson 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Minutes: None to approve.

Old Business: None.

New Business: **Challenges.**

Nathan Young. Felon since 12/19/23 and has not had rights restored. Sustained-unanimous.

Larry Booker. Felon since 1/19/81 and has not had rights restored. Sustained-unanimous.

Timothy Lyda. Felon since 10/24/24 and has not had rights restored. Sustained-unanimous.

Frederick Scheel. Died 10/27/24. Sustained- unanimous.

Tabulate and add results for approved Election Day ballots for Clear Creek Precinct-Emergency Bin. The tabulator issue caused the Emergency Bin to be used, and the ballots were returned in a sealed plastic envelope instead of being run through the tabulator on Election night. Member Rebuck moved to allow staff to feed the ballots through the tabulator. Member Pearson 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Opened the Clear Creek scanner and zero tape was run and signed by the Board.

Public Count: 0 Scanned: 181 Ballots.

Closing Public Count: 181. Closed poll and printed results tape and signed by the Board; Board completed and signed the Vote Total Verification forms.

Review Hand to Eye Count. Long John Mountain Precinct and Early Voting in Etowah were chosen to recount. DS200 scanner count was the same; Long John Mountain Precinct 340 votes, Etowah Early Voting 2,800 votes.
