1st Protest Hearing Griffin/Riggs

Agenda: Consideration of Griffin/Riggs Protest.

Old Business: None.

Chair Comments: NC Supreme Court Candidate Griffin filed protests in Henderson County at 4:49 PM, Tuesday, 11/19. Protests were also filed in most of the 100 counties. Chair read the SBOE Order dated 11/20/24, taking jurisdiction of 3 of the 6 issues protested statewide. Two of the four issues we received will be handled by the state, to wit: Overseas votes and voters with no driver's license or Social Security numbers on file. This Board will review the protests on voters who died before election day and voters whose registrations were denied and ineligible to vote. We are charged today with deciding if the Protest was timely filed and if there is probable cause to go forward with an Evidentiary Hearing on the latter issues.


New Business. After discussion, Member Rebeck moved that Candidate Griffin's protests were timely filed and that probable cause was found to move forward to an Evidentiary Hearing. Member Pearson 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Said Hearing is set for Dec. 2, 2024, at 1 PM.


There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:17 PM.


