The following items shall be incorporated as part of the Contract Documents:

- 1. Bid Date is April 10, 2019 at 2:30 PM. The Bidder is responsible for the bid arrival by this time. Bid bond or payment and performance bonds are not anticipated.
- 2. The contract will be signed on or after July 1, 2019, and the notice to proceed will follow immediately.
- 3. The Bid Form is revised from substantial completion in 60 calendar days to work shall be substantially complete before August 26, 2019.
- 4. The skylight solar tubes are Alternate #1.
- 5. The scope of the project was reviewed. The project consists of two parts.
  - a. Part One: The pre cast concrete panels at the gymnasium parapet wall will be removed and replaced with metal stud framing and metal fascia. The metal fascia is to match the existing fascia at the adjacent office.
  - b. Part Two: The skylight at the cafeteria ramp will be removed and replaced with a roof structure and suspended ceiling.
- 6. The gym parapet wall work will require safety measures. A plan to vacate affected areas of the school building during the removal of the concrete panels must be in place and adhered to by the HCPS and the contractor. The contractor will have an unobstructed schedule during the removal process of the concrete panels so as to efficiently complete this portion of the work. Assistant Principal John McDaris agreed that affected areas of the school building can be vacated for this portion of the work.
- 7. The precast concrete panel dimension are corrected to 48" long x 16" high x 4" thick.
- 8. Assistant Principal John McDaris noted that Principal John Shepard wishes to recess the suspended ceiling to create a feature above the ramp. This will be considered as an alternate in the bid documents.
- 9. The light fixtures in the proposed skylight ceiling shall be LED type. HCPS will provide a model #.
- 10. The sites were visited.






