ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS


- What property is subject to taxation? Property taxes are levied on real property (land and buildings), personal property (unregistered motor vehicles, aircraft, watercraft and manufactured homes) and personal property used in the production of income. Property taxes are levied on registered (tagged) motor vehicles at the Department of Motor Vehicles when the tag is purchased or renewed. These taxes are then transferred to the County by the State and become part of the County's property tax levy. Taxes are paid to Henderson County and the municipality or rural fire district in which you live. If you live in the municipalities of Fletcher, Flat Rock or Mills River, you will receive a separate tax bill from that municipality.
- Can I appeal the value of my Real Property? The value of real property must have been appealed to the Board of Equalization & Review between January 1, 2024 and April 29, 2024 (the advertised adjournment date of the County's Board of Equalization and Review).
- Can I appeal the value of my Personal Property? Any taxpayer may appeal the value, situs or taxability of personal property within 30 days after the date of the initial notice of value NCGS 105-317.1(c). If no previous notice of value has been created (per audit or discovery), this bill will serve as the official notification of value for personal property only.
- I sold my Real Property. Who is responsible for payment of the tax? If real property is transferred to a new owner and taxes become delinquent, the owner as of the delinquency date (01/07/2025) or any subsequent owner thereafter, is responsible for payment of the tax.
- I sold my Personal Property. Who is responsible for the tax? If you owned the property on January 1, you are responsible for payment of the tax.
- What if I don't pay my tax on time? Beginning on 01/07/2025, interest will accrue and enforcement remedies become necessary. Enforcement remedies include (but are not limited to) advertisement of real property tax liens, foreclosure, wage garnishment, state income tax garnishment, and bank account attachment. If you are unable to pay your tax bill on time, please contact the Collector's office at (828) 697-5595 before the bill becomes delinquent. In most cases, taxpayers will be given the option to enter into a payment plan.
- Is there a fee for Returned Checks? Returned checks are subject to a fee of \$25 or 10% of the amount of the check, whichever is greater, up to a maximum of \$1,000 NCGS 105-357(b)(2).


What do property taxes pay for?

Property taxes are the largest source of revenue to fund the many services we count on each day.  Where do your Henderson County Property Tax Dollars go?
The Henderson County Tax portion of the total tax bill is used to fund operations for County Government, Henderson County Public Schools, and Blue Ridge Community College.

>On a bill where the amount due for Henderson County Tax is \$1,000.00:

- o \$500.70 funds County Government Operations
- o \$391.93 funds Henderson County Public Schools \$339.40 for operational expenses and \$52.53 for capital

o \$107.37 funds Blue Ridge Community
