Draft Minutes October 18, 2017. Mr. Jim Crafton made a motion to approve the October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017 minutes, Mr. John Dockendorf seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.

## **Discussion**

<u>Presentation on Potential Corridor Study Program</u>. Mrs. Lyuba Zuyeva from the French Broad River MPO gave a presentation on a proposed corridor study program for the MPO. This program would help to conduct corridor studies in the MPO's planning area in order to identify potential improvements, needs, and obstacles for corridors that are being or might be considered for funding in the future.

<u>Public Comment.</u> Mrs. Kumor opened the floor for public comment. Several people expressed concerns regarding the Kanuga Rd. widening project. Several citizens expressed concerns on the proposed 64W Project. Larry Rogers voiced concerns over the impact future White St. changes might have on area businesses. All comments were received by District Engineer Steve Cannon to be relayed to NCDOT for consideration. Commissioner Bill Lapsley once again thanked the citizens for relaying their concerns, and also promised to relay the same concerns to the Henderson County Board of Commissioners. Mrs. Kumor invited citizens to sign up for the County Newsletter (signup form can be found <u>here</u>) in order to stay informed on upcoming projects. **<u>Routine Updates</u>** Mr. Steve Canon gave updates on several projects including improvements near Continental Teves, several small bridge projects, and minor drainage improvements.

John Dockendorf from the Village of Flat Rock gave an update on the public input meeting for the Highland Lake Rd. Project.
