Henderson County TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE March 25, 2010

The Transportation Advisory Committee met on March 25, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. in the King Street Meeting Room at 100 N. King Street, Hendersonville. Members present were Chairman Jim Crafton; County Commissioner Bill Moyer, David Jones, at-large; Steve Caraker, City of Hendersonville; and Eddie Henderson, Town of Fletcher. Staff members included; Hope Bleecker, Transportation Planner; Autumn Radcliff, Senior Planner and Kathleen Scanlan, Secretary. Also present was Bo Ferguson, City Manager, City of Hendersonville and William Moyer, Commissioner. Don Farr, Robert Vickery and Renee Kumor were absent.

Chairman's Report

The minutes of the January 28, 2010 meeting were tabled until the next regularly scheduled meeting because there was not a quorum of voting members present to approve them.

Chairman Crafton discussed a new modified schedule for the meetings because there is now a conflict with the Henderson County TAC, since the MPO has scheduled additional monthly meetings this year. In their discussion, members tentatively decided to move the future meetings on the 1st Wednesday of May, July, September and October at 3 p.m. for the remainder of 2010. For example, the next meeting would be May 5, 2010. Staff will contact the other members to check their schedules and approve these dates at the next meeting.

Mr. Crafton mentioned the vacant at-large seat that Terry Hicks had and asked Commissioner Moyer if it has been addressed by the Commissioners. Mr. Moyer said it hasn't as of yet.

Mr. Crafton said he attended a Congestion Management Meeting sponsored by the French Broad MPO and facilitated by Don Kostalec. The Traffic Congestion workshop met and discussed priorities and input where congested roadways are located in order to lend input to the Long Range Plan and provide feedback to NCDOT.

Long Range Plan Survey

Ms. Bleecker presented a summary list of transportation priority projects. TAC and TCC members are going to get a homework assignment to prioritize transportation projects and she encouraged the Henderson County TAC members to discuss their priorities in advance of the survey deadline. Ms. Bleecker explained the draft work lists of various transportation projects. Mr. Crafton suggested that the Committee review these priorities and give their input regarding what items they feel should be considered and rank them according to importance. After considerable discussion, the following items were considered to be unranked priorities:
