Draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan

The TAC members discussed the various projects and received clarification from Mr. Winkler about the difference between these projects and those that are already funded/submitted into SPOT last summer. Commissioner Bill Lapsley made the motion to approve the draft projects for the 2045 MTP and Commissioner Rebecca McCall seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Updates & Other Business:

NCDOT

Steve Williams from NCDOT's Division 14 updated the TAC about current construction projects (see attached). All projects in development that do not have NC Build funding are on hold until further notice. Locally administered projects are also on hold. Mr. Williams also mentioned the state House Bill 77 is being reviewed by the state legislature. The bill would release a large sum of funds for NCDOT use.

City of Hendersonville

Councilwoman Hensley updated the TAC that the City is moving forward with their sidewalk improvements in historic downtown.
