Public Comment:

Approval of Agenda and Minutes:

Vice Mayor Anne Coletta moved to approve, and Councilman Jim Player seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion:

SPOT 7.0 Discussion

Mr. Tristan Winkler presented on prioritization:

Prioritization helps determine which projects should be funded next. Regional impact projects (projects on US and NC highways) compete across regions. Ours is Region G, Divisions 13 and 14. Projects in this area compete for the same regional impact funds, distributed based on population. It should be noted that local input does play a role in what's funded. Seventy percent comes from the quantitative score, and 30% comes from local input. The funding time period is between 2026 and 2035. Region G is expected to have -\$191 million during that time. The chances of something being funded in this round are very unlikely.

After a thoughtful discussion on improving safety and prioritizing areas with poor access management over widenings, Mr. John Connet made a motion. The motion included keeping project numbers 1 and 5-8 in the same order but rearranging projects 2-4 so that number 2 becomes US176, number 3 NC 280, and number 4 US 25 Business at N Main St. Mayor Gonce seconded the motion. The motion carried. The revised order is attached.

Updates:

NCDOT Update

Please see the attached document for construction and development updates. Mr. Rusty Darnell elaborated on some projects of note, including the 26-25 interchange, which was scheduled to be completed in July '24 but is 46% complete—it should be substantially complete by the end of the summer. Green River is 70% complete and scheduled to be complete by February '26, but it is now likely late summer '26. I-26 is tracked to be substantially complete by the end of the summer. The North Main /US 25 Business is showing 83% completion. Erosion inspections and permits have been granted, and the project is expected to be closed out in the next couple of months. Ecusta Trail is on its way. I-26 drainage at Saluda Grade is 70% complete and should be done by late summer. There has been no change in delivery dates for projects under development since March. S. Mills Gap Bridge is still under design, but they hope it will be open by April '25. Vice Mayor Anne Coletta commented that Steve Williams gave an update on N. Highland Lake Rd. at the last MPO meeting, which included a new completion date of July 2025. Rusty couldn't confirm, but Steve was online and confirmed that the date did change. Commissioner Bill Lapsley pointed out a typo on the spreadsheet: it states that the Ecusta Trail cost \$1.19 million when it should be \$11.19 million.

Henderson County

Commissioner McCall shared that the Ecusta Trail is well on its way to completion.

Village of Flat Rock

Vice Mayor Anne Coletta stated that North Highland Lake Rd. is closed to through traffic at the Greenville Hwy section. She hopes it will only last a few more months.

Town of Mills River

Mayor Gonce shared that he traveled on Cane Creek to Fairview and noticed that the preschool play area is dangerous near the road. Some sort of barrier is needed to ensure that no cars travel into the play area. He also said he requested NCDOT to place signage on Hooper Lane to improve safety. He stated that a guardrail was requested at Pleasant Grove/Etowah School. Rusty responded that the guardrail was already put in.

Members At Large

Mr. Warren Ladbrook asked for an update on Ecusta Trail Partners. Mrs. Janna Bianculli responded that a meeting is coming up soon, and the group is active.

Dawn Barr shared that she recently attended a traffic safety conference and learned a lot about the intricacies of transportation planning, data collection, and analysis.

Mr. Tristan Winkler shared about the Safe Streets for All leadership summit the next day and starting that work.

The next TAC meeting is scheduled for August 21, 2024.

The meeting adjourned at 4:50 PM.
