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### **Detailed Scope of Work:**

- Furnish the necessary supervision, labor, tools, equipment and materials to complete the required work inclusive of:
  - 1. Systematic and scheduled demolition, removal and disposal of the existing RTU's being replaced.
  - 2. Installation of the new RTU's inclusive of all rigging, crane, vehicle traffic control, pedestrian control and safety measures, all high/low voltage and all control wiring connections as required. This is a turnkey job.
  - 3. Job scope includes any/all roof modifications/repairs required for the new unit installation (i.e. unit curbs, flashings etc.).
  - 4. The job scope is inclusive of the replacement of 15 RTU's ranging from 5 to 15 tons with a total tonnage of 154.5 tons. Replace each unit with an identical size unit and per the current Building, Mechanical, and Energy Code and with economizers incorporated in each unit.
  - 5. Smoke detectors are located in the ductwork below the units and will not need to be changed, modified, or removed and reinstalled.
  - 6. Approved equipment manufacturers are limited to: Trane, Carrier
  - 7. Warranties will include a minimum 5 years all parts, compressors with a 10 year warranty, and a 1 year unlimited labor warranty.
  - 8. Provide alternate pricing for high efficiency units inclusive of all costs.
- Provide for landfill and hauling fees if required.
- Restore all disturbed areas in and around the site.
- Work limitations to be discussed at the mandatory Pre-Bid meeting.
- All approved work schedules will be coordinated with Thad Ninnemann.
- Obtain all required permits and inspections.

## The following information must be included in the proposal:

- 1. Proposals are to be in the form of a Proposed Contract signed by the bidder and ready for the County's signature:
  - a. Include lump sum price for base bid inclusive of all work required.



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- b. Include separate pricing for any proposed alternates.
- c. Include equipment delivery date, project start date, and projected completion date.
- d. Proposals will be awarded based on base bid, equipment delivery date, project start date, and projected completion date.
- 2. All applicable Contractor's Licensures with North Carolina.
- 3. See Henderson County Insurance and Bond Requirements posted under General Information at <a href="http://ww2.hendersoncountync.org/rfp/index.html">http://ww2.hendersoncountync.org/rfp/index.html</a> for the following:
  - a. Insurance (if appropriate) per Article 11
  - b. Bonds (if appropriate) per Article 12

- 5. As a party wishing to contract or otherwise do business with Henderson County, You must understand that you have a duty (imposed by North Carolina law in 2013), as a condition of payment for goods provided or services rendered, to Comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes (E-Verify). Further, if you provide the goods and services to the County utilizing a subcontractor, you must require the subcontractor to comply With the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes as well. You are required to verify, by affidavit, compliance of these terms of this Section upon the County's request.
